1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HomePro SDIK-2000 Sliding Door Installation Kit. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient installation, operation, and maintenance of your new sliding door system. Please read this manual thoroughly before beginning installation and keep it for future reference.

1.1 Safety Information

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

2.2 Tools Required

- Pencil
- Level
- Drill with appropriate bits
- Screwdriver (Phillips head)
- Wrench (adjustable)

2.3 Installation Steps

1. **Prepare the Opening:** Ensure the door opening is plumb, level, and square. Measure the width and height to confirm compatibility with your door.
2. **Mount the Track:** Using the provided template, mark the drilling locations for the sliding track. Drill pilot holes and securely fasten the track to the wall or header using the supplied mounting hardware. Ensure the track is perfectly level.
3. **Attach Hangers to Door:** Install the hanger brackets onto the top edge of your door panel according to the template. Ensure they are aligned and securely fastened.
4. **Hang the Door:** Carefully lift the door panel and engage the hanger rollers with the sliding track. Gently test the door's movement along the track.
5. **Install Floor Guide:** Position the floor guide at the bottom of the door opening to prevent the door from swinging out. Mark and drill holes, then secure the guide to the floor.
6. **Adjust Door Stops:** Install the door stops at the desired open and closed positions on the track to prevent the door from rolling off the ends.
7. **Final Adjustments:** Check the door's alignment and smooth operation. Make any necessary adjustments to the hangers or stops.

3. OPERATING YOUR SLIDING DOOR

3.1 Basic Operation

3.2 Adjustments

- **Door Height:** If the door drags on the floor or has too much clearance, the hanger bolts can be adjusted. Loosen the locking nuts on the hangers, adjust the bolts up or down, and then re-tighten the locking nuts.
- **Door Stops:** To change the open or closed position, loosen the set screws on the door stops, slide them to the new desired position, and re-tighten.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and smooth operation of your HomePro sliding door system.

4.1 Cleaning

- **Track:** Periodically clean the sliding track with a damp cloth to remove dust and debris. Accumulated dirt can impede smooth operation.
- **Rollers:** Wipe the rollers clean. Avoid using abrasive cleaners.

4.2 Lubrication

Apply a silicone-based lubricant to the sliding track and roller bearings every 6-12 months, or if you notice increased friction or noise. Do not use oil-based lubricants as they can attract dust.

4.3 Periodic Checks

- Inspect all mounting hardware for tightness. Re-tighten any loose screws.
- Check the door stops to ensure they are securely in place.
- Verify the door moves freely and does not bind or drag.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your sliding door system.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Door is difficult to slide or noisy.	Dirt or debris in track. Lack of lubrication. Loose or worn rollers.	Clean track thoroughly. Apply silicone lubricant to track and rollers. Inspect and tighten/replace rollers if necessary.
Door drags on the floor.	Hangers not adjusted correctly. Track not level.	Adjust hanger bolts to raise the door. Re-level the track.
Door swings out at the bottom.	Floor guide not installed or improperly positioned.	Install or adjust the floor guide.
