1. INTRODUCTION

The Clickfree Automatic Backup Portable External Hard Drive is designed to simplify the crucial task of backing up your digital files. This device offers an effortless, automatic backup solution for your precious photos, music, videos, emails, and more, supporting over 400 file types. It requires no software installation or complex setup, making data backup accessible to all users. One Clickfree drive can be used to back up multiple computers, and it is compatible with both Windows and Mac operating systems.

3. SETUP GUIDE

Setting up your Clickfree Automatic Backup drive is designed to be straightforward and requires no prior software installation.

1. **Unpack the Device:** Carefully remove the Clickfree Portable External Hard Drive from its packaging.
2. **Locate the USB Cable:** Identify the supplied USB cable. This cable provides both power and data connectivity.
3. **Connect to Computer:** Plug one end of the USB cable into the Clickfree drive and the other end into an available USB port on your computer. For optimal performance, use a direct USB port on your computer rather than a USB hub.
4. **Initial Recognition:** Your computer will automatically detect the Clickfree drive. This process may take a few moments.
5. **Begin Backup:** Once detected, the Clickfree software pre-loaded on the drive will automatically launch and initiate the backup process. No manual software installation is required.

Note: If AutoRun is disabled on your computer, you may need to manually open the drive from "My Computer" or "This PC" and double-click the Clickfree executable file to start the backup.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Automatic Backup Process

The primary function of the Clickfree drive is its automatic backup capability. Once connected, the device will scan your computer for user-created files and begin backing them up.

- **First Backup:** The initial backup will take longer as it copies all identified files. Ensure the drive remains connected and your computer is powered on during this process.
- **Subsequent Backups:** For subsequent backups, simply connect the drive again. The Clickfree system will intelligently identify and back up only new or modified files since the last backup, significantly reducing backup time.
- **File Types:** The drive automatically backs up common file types such as documents, photos, videos, music, and emails. It does not back up operating system files or installed programs.

4.2 Restoring Files

To restore files from your Clickfree drive to your computer (or a new computer):

1. Connect the Clickfree drive to the computer where you wish to restore files.
2. Launch the Clickfree application (it should auto-run or be accessible from the drive).
3. Follow the on-screen prompts to select the files or folders you wish to restore. You can choose to restore all files or specific items.
4. Confirm the restoration location on your computer.
5. Allow the process to complete.

4.3 Managing Multiple Computers

The Clickfree drive is designed to manage backups from multiple computers. It automatically organizes and separates data from different systems, preventing file conflicts.

- Simply connect the drive to each computer you wish to back up. The system will recognize the computer and manage its backup independently.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Safe Disconnection:** Always safely eject the Clickfree drive from your computer before unplugging it to prevent data corruption.
- **Physical Care:** Keep the drive in a clean, dry environment. Avoid extreme temperatures, direct sunlight, and physical shocks.
- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the drive. Do not use liquid cleaners or solvents.
- **Firmware Updates:** Periodically check the Clickfree official website for any available firmware updates for your model to ensure optimal performance and compatibility.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drive not detected.	Loose USB connection; insufficient power; faulty USB port.	Ensure USB cable is securely connected. Try a different USB port on your computer. Avoid using unpowered USB hubs.
Backup does not start automatically.	AutoRun disabled; software conflict.	Manually open the drive from "My Computer" and run the Clickfree executable. Check your computer's AutoPlay settings.
Backup process is slow.	Large number of files; fragmented drive; background processes.	The first backup will always be the slowest. Close unnecessary applications. Ensure your computer's hard drive is not heavily fragmented.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cannot transfer files from PC to Mac (or vice-versa).	Drive formatted for a specific OS.	The Clickfree drive formats itself for either PC or Mac upon first use. It cannot be used for direct cross-platform file transfer without reformatting (which erases all data). For cross-platform transfer, use cloud services or network sharing.
