Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your DOMETIC CDF-18 Portable Compressor Cooler and Freezer. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To prevent injury or damage, observe the following safety guidelines:

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the specifications on the unit's rating plate.
- Do not operate the appliance if it is visibly damaged.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of obstructions.

- Do not use electrical devices inside the cooler unless they are recommended by the manufacturer.
- · Avoid touching exposed cables with bare hands.
- This appliance can be used by children aged 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present and undamaged:

- 1 x DOMETIC CDF-18 Portable Compressor Cooler and Freezer
- 1 x Instruction Manual (this document)
- 1 x DC Connection Cable (12/24V)

SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the cooler from its packaging. Retain packaging for future transport or storage.
- 2. **Placement:** Place the cooler on a firm, level surface. Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit, especially the compressor area. Avoid direct sunlight or heat sources.
- 3. **Power Connection:** Connect the DC cable to the cooler's power input. Then, connect the other end to a 12V or 24V DC power source (e.g., vehicle cigarette lighter socket).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Power On/Off:** The unit powers on automatically when connected to a power source. To turn off, disconnect the power cable.
- 2. **Temperature Setting:** Use the 'Temperature' rotary dial to set the desired cooling level. Turning towards 'COLD' increases cooling (lower temperature), and towards 'FREEZE' enables deep freezing down to -18°C.
- 3. **Battery Monitor:** The 'Battery Monitor' switch protects your vehicle battery from excessive discharge. Select 'HIGH' for sensitive batteries (e.g., starting batteries) or 'LOW' for less sensitive batteries (e.g., leisure batteries). The unit will switch off if the battery voltage drops below the selected threshold.
- 4. **Loading the Cooler:** Place items inside the cooler. For optimal performance, pre-cool items if possible. The internal divider can help organize contents.

MAINTENANCE


- **Cleaning:** Clean the interior and exterior of the cooler regularly with a damp cloth. Use mild soap if necessary. Do not use abrasive cleaners or sharp objects.
- **Ventilation:** Periodically check that the ventilation grilles are free from dust and debris to ensure efficient operation.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, ensure the cooler is clean and dry. Store with the lid slightly ajar to prevent odors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cooler does not turn on.	No power supply; low battery voltage; faulty cable.	Check power connection; ensure battery is charged; inspect cable for damage.
Insufficient cooling.	Temperature setting too high; poor ventilation; too much warm content.	Adjust temperature dial to 'COLD' or 'FREEZE'; clear ventilation openings; pre-cool items before loading.
Unusual noise.	Unit not level; fan obstruction.	Ensure cooler is on a level surface; check for obstructions in the fan.
