1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Adherence to these safety guidelines is crucial for preventing injury and ensuring the longevity of your bunk bed.

- Ensure the bed frame is properly assembled to prevent instability or collapse.
- Each bunk supports a maximum weight of **250 lbs**. Do not exceed this limit.
- Use mattresses with a thickness between **5 and 9 inches**. Thicker mattresses may compromise guardrail effectiveness.
- Always use the integrated guardrails on the top bunk.
- Be cautious of potential pinch points during assembly and use.
- Always follow the manufacturer's instructions for assembly, use, and maintenance.
- The ladder should be securely attached and used for climbing to the top bunk.

3. SETUP & ASSEMBLY

Your Walker Edison bunk bed ships ready-to-assemble with step-by-step instructions included in the packaging. Assembly typically requires two people and can be completed in approximately 2-3 hours.

3.1 Key Assembly Tips

- **Read Instructions First:** Familiarize yourself with all steps before beginning.

- **Upper Rails:** When assembling the bunk beds, ensure the upper rails with the most holes are facing down. These holes are necessary for ladder installation.
- **Slats Tabs:** The small gray tabs that stabilize the bed slats have a flush end and a slightly raised end. The flush end should go next to the rail. Using channel locks with tape or padding can assist in snapping them into place.
- **Ladder Placement:** The ladder can be attached to either end of the bunk bed, offering flexibility for room arrangement.
- **Component Check:** Verify all hardware and components are present before starting. Hardware is typically blister-packed and labeled to correspond with instructions.




Image: Detailed dimensions of the bunk bed, including height, length, and width.






Image: Close-up of a connection point on the metal frame, illustrating the secure assembly.

4. USAGE GUIDELINES

The Elodie bunk bed is designed for efficient space utilization and can be configured as a twin-over-twin bunk bed or separated into two individual twin beds.

4.1 Configuration Options

- **Bunk Bed:** Provides two sleeping surfaces in the footprint of a single twin bed. Ideal for shared rooms or maximizing space.
- **Two Twin Beds:** The bunk bed can be disassembled and reconfigured into two separate twin beds, offering versatility as needs change.

4.2 Mattress Recommendations

For optimal safety and comfort, a mattress thickness of 5 to 9 inches is recommended for both the top and bottom bunks. This ensures adequate guardrail height on the top bunk and sufficient headroom on the bottom bunk.




Image: Front view of the bunk bed, showing the integrated ladder and safety rails.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps preserve the condition and safety of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal surfaces with a dry cloth to remove dust and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners that may damage the finish.
- **Fastener Check:** Periodically check and tighten all bolts and screws to ensure the bed remains sturdy and stable. Loose fasteners can lead to wobbling or instability.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Below are common issues and their potential solutions:

6.1 Bed Squeaking

- **Cause:** Loose connections or metal-on-metal friction.
- **Solution:** Tighten all assembly bolts and screws. Applying a small amount of lubricant (e.g., WD-40) to metal-on-metal contact points can help reduce noise.

6.2 Ladder Discomfort

- **Cause:** Narrow ladder rungs can be uncomfortable for bare feet.
- **Solution:** Consider adding padding or wraps to the ladder rungs for improved comfort.
