INTRODUCTION

TROUBLESHOOTING

Device not powering on after battery replacement:

- If the device still does not work, the battery may be faulty, or there might be an issue with the device itself. Try a new battery if available.

Short battery life:

- Ensure the battery is a genuine Renata SR55.
- Check the device for any abnormal power drain.
- Consider the age of the battery; even unused batteries have a shelf life.
