INTRODUCTION

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

For the Keyboard:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the keyboard.
- 2. Open the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Insert the required batteries (typically AAA, refer to the compartment label for exact type and polarity) ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

For the Mouse:

- 1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the mouse.
- 2. Open the battery compartment cover.
- 3. Insert the required batteries (typically AAA, refer to the compartment label for exact type and polarity) ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
- 4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

2. Connecting the USB Receiver

The USB receiver is typically stored in the battery compartment of the mouse for safe keeping during transport. Retrieve the receiver before proceeding.

- 1. Locate an available USB port on your computer (PC, laptop, or desktop).
- 2. Insert the 2-in-1 USB receiver firmly into the USB port.
- 3. Your computer should automatically detect and install the necessary drivers. This process may take a few moments.

3. Powering On

Once the batteries are installed and the USB receiver is connected, the keyboard and mouse should automatically establish a connection with your computer. There is typically no power button on these devices; they activate upon battery insertion and receiver connection.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Keyboard Usage

The keyboard functions as a standard 104-key layout. All keys operate as they would on a wired keyboard. The

membrane tactile switches are designed to provide comfort to your fingers during extended use. Laser printing on the keycaps ensures durability and resistance to wear.

Mouse Usage

The optical mouse offers precise tracking and control. It features three buttons (left, right, and scroll wheel button) and a scrolling capability. The unique ambidextrous shape is designed for comfortable use by either hand. Simply move the mouse on a flat surface to control the cursor on your screen. The scroll wheel allows for easy navigation through documents and web pages.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your wireless keyboard and mouse combo, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to clean the surfaces of the keyboard and mouse. For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water or a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid excessive moisture.
- Spill-Resistant Design: While the keyboard is spill-resistant, it is not waterproof. In case of a spill, immediately disconnect the receiver, remove batteries, and allow the keyboard to dry completely before reuse.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when performance degrades or devices become unresponsive. Always use fresh batteries of the specified type.
- **Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, remove the batteries to prevent leakage. Store the devices in a cool, dry place.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your ProHT wireless combo, try the following solutions:

• No Connection / Unresponsive Devices:

- Ensure the USB receiver is securely plugged into a working USB port on your computer. Try a different USB port.
- Check the batteries in both the keyboard and mouse. Replace them with fresh ones if necessary, ensuring correct polarity.
- Move the keyboard and mouse closer to the USB receiver to rule out range issues.
- · Restart your computer.

· Lagging or Intermittent Connection:

- Ensure there are no large metal objects or other wireless devices (like Wi-Fi routers, cordless phones) operating on the 2.4GHz frequency too close to the receiver, as they can cause interference.
- Try moving the receiver to a different USB port, preferably one on the front of your computer for better line of sight.

• Mouse Cursor Jumps or is Inaccurate:

- Ensure the optical sensor on the underside of the mouse is clean and free of debris.
- Use the mouse on a clean, non-reflective, and uniform surface. Mouse pads are recommended.

· Keyboard Keys Not Responding:

Check for any physical obstructions under the keys.

• Ensure the keyboard batteries are fresh and correctly installed.






