INTRODUCTION

The NuWave Infrared Oven is engineered to cook a variety of foods, including meats, poultry, and fish, efficiently and effectively. Utilizing infrared technology, it cooks foods quickly while maintaining internal moisture and achieving a crisp, browned exterior, often without the need for added fats or oils. Its compact, lightweight, and portable design makes it suitable for various environments such as RVs, dorms, boats, or as an auxiliary oven for larger gatherings. The clear plastic dome allows for visual monitoring of the cooking process. This versatile appliance supports multiple cooking functions including barbecuing, roasting, grilling, baking, broiling, dehydrating, steaming, and air frying.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed. Place the NuWave Infrared Oven on a stable, heat-resistant surface with adequate ventilation around the unit. Do not place the oven directly against a wall or under cabinets that may be damaged by heat or steam.

Included Components:

- Main Power Head with Digital Controls
- Clear Plastic Dome
- Dome Holder

- Cooking Rack (Grill)
- Base Unit
- Extender Ring (if included with your model)

Assemble the unit by placing the cooking rack inside the base, then positioning the clear plastic dome securely on the base. Finally, place the power head on top of the dome, ensuring it is properly seated. If using the extender ring, place it between the base and the dome to increase cooking capacity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The NuWave Infrared Oven features digital controls for precise cooking. Familiarize yourself with the control panel located on the power head.

Control Panel Overview:

- **Number Buttons (1-9):** Used to set cooking time and power level.
- **Quick Look Button:** Allows for brief interruption of cooking to check food.
- **Power Level Button:** Adjusts the cooking power.
- **Timer Only Button:** Activates the timer function without cooking.
- **Start Button:** Initiates the cooking cycle.
- **Pause/Clear Button:** Pauses cooking or clears current settings.

Basic Cooking Steps:

1. Prepare your food and place it on the cooking rack inside the oven.
2. Ensure the dome and power head are correctly assembled.
3. Plug the oven into a standard electrical outlet.
4. Press the **Power Level** button to select the desired cooking power (e.g., P1 for low, P10 for high).
5. Use the number buttons to enter the desired cooking time in minutes.
6. Press the **Start** button to begin cooking.
7. Monitor food through the clear dome. Use the **Quick Look** button to briefly pause and check food without resetting the timer.
8. When cooking is complete, the oven will automatically shut off. Carefully remove food using heat-resistant mitts.

Cooking Functions:

The NuWave Infrared Oven is capable of various cooking methods:

- **Barbecue:** Ideal for achieving grilled textures and flavors.
- **Roast:** Perfect for whole chickens, roasts, and larger cuts of meat.
- **Grill:** Suitable for steaks, burgers, and vegetables.
- **Bake:** For items like cakes, cookies, and casseroles.
- **Broil:** For browning and crisping the top layer of food.
- **Dehydrate:** For drying fruits, vegetables, and making jerky.
- **Steam:** For gentle cooking of vegetables and seafood.
- **Air Fry:** For achieving crispy results with minimal oil.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your NuWave Infrared Oven. Always unplug the unit and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.

- **Power Head:** Wipe the exterior of the power head with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the power head in water or any other liquid.
- **Clear Plastic Dome:** The dome can be washed by hand with warm, soapy water or placed in the dishwasher. Handle with care to prevent scratches or damage.
- **Cooking Rack and Base:** These components are typically dishwasher safe or can be washed by hand with warm, soapy water.
- **Extender Ring:** Wash with warm, soapy water.

Avoid using abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals, as these can damage the surfaces of the oven components.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your NuWave Infrared Oven, consult the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **Oven does not turn on:**
 - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
 - Check if the power head is properly seated on the dome.
 - Verify that the outlet is receiving power (test with another appliance).
- **Food not cooking evenly:**
 - Ensure food is placed centrally on the cooking rack.
 - Avoid overcrowding the oven; cook in smaller batches if necessary.
 - Consider flipping or rotating food halfway through cooking for larger items.
- **Dome appears cracked or damaged:**
 - Discontinue use immediately.
 - Contact NuWave customer support for replacement parts.
- **Digital display not working:**
 - Unplug the unit, wait a few minutes, and plug it back in to reset.
 - If the issue persists, contact customer support.
