# Brother SA132 Quilting Guide Instruction Manual

Model: SA132

## INTRODUCTION

The Brother SA132 Quilting Guide is an accessory designed to assist in creating precise, parallel stitch lines for quilting and other sewing projects. This guide attaches to your sewing machine's presser foot ankle or walking foot, allowing for consistent spacing between stitch rows.

It is a genuine Brother accessory, compatible with all 7mm feed dog machines, and offers easy adjustment for various measurement changes.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to properly install the Brother SA132 Quilting Guide onto your sewing machine:

- 1. Identify the Guide Hole:** Locate the small guide hole on the back of your sewing machine's presser foot ankle or walking foot. This hole is specifically designed for accessories like the quilting guide.
- 2. Insert the Guide Bar:** Gently slide the straight metal bar of the SA132 Quilting Guide into this guide hole. Ensure it is inserted securely.
- 3. Adjust Position:** The guide should slide freely left and right within the hole. Position it to the desired distance from your needle, which will determine the spacing of your parallel stitch lines.
- 4. Verify Stability:** Ensure the guide is stable and does not interfere with the needle or other moving parts of the sewing machine.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once the quilting guide is installed, follow these steps for effective use:

- 1. Set Initial Stitch:** Sew your first line of stitches on your fabric as a reference.
- 2. Position the Guide:** Adjust the SA132 Quilting Guide so that its curved end runs along the previously sewn stitch line. The distance between the needle and the guide's end will be the spacing for your new

stitch line.

- 3. Sew Parallel Lines:** Begin sewing, keeping the guide's end consistently aligned with the previous stitch line. This will ensure your new stitch line is perfectly parallel and evenly spaced.
- 4. Adjust Spacing:** To change the spacing between stitch lines, simply slide the guide bar left or right within the presser foot's guide hole before sewing the next line.

This method allows for quick and accurate creation of multiple parallel stitch lines, ideal for quilting, topstitching, and decorative sewing.

## MAINTENANCE

---

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your Brother SA132 Quilting Guide:

- Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the guide with a soft, dry cloth to remove any lint or dust accumulation. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- Storage:** Store the guide in a clean, dry place when not in use to prevent damage or loss.
- Inspection:** Regularly inspect the guide for any signs of wear or damage. If the guide becomes bent or broken, it may affect stitching accuracy and should be replaced.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues while using the Brother SA132 Quilting Guide, consider the following:

- Uneven Stitching:** Ensure the guide is securely inserted into the presser foot's guide hole and that you are consistently aligning it with the previous stitch line. Check that the fabric is feeding smoothly.
- Guide Not Fitting:** Verify that your sewing machine's presser foot ankle or walking foot has a compatible guide hole. The SA132 is designed for specific Brother models and 7mm feed dog machines. Refer to the "Compatible Models" section.
- Difficulty Sliding:** If the guide does not slide smoothly, check for any obstructions in the guide hole or on the guide bar itself. Clean as necessary.
