1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your Severin CM 2198 Crepe Maker. Please read these instructions thoroughly before first use and keep them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- · Keep out of reach of children.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate the appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- · Avoid touching hot surfaces. Use handles or knobs.
- Use only accessories recommended by the manufacturer.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Severin CM 2198 is an electric crepe maker designed for convenient preparation of crepes and pancakes. It features a non-stick coated crepe pan with a diameter of approximately 30 cm.

Components:

- · Crepe Maker Unit with non-stick cooking surface
- · Wooden Spatula
- Wooden Crepe Turning Stick

Key Features:

- High-quality plastic housing
- Variable thermostat with 6 power levels
- On/Off switch
- Pilot light and ready-to-use indicator
- Cable storage
- Non-slip feet

4. SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the crepe maker and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or disposal.
- 2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe the non-stick cooking surface with a damp cloth and dry thoroughly. Clean the wooden spatula and turning stick with warm soapy water and rinse well.
- 3. **Placement:** Place the crepe maker on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the appliance.
- 4. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. Note that the power cord is approximately 86.5 cm long, so position the appliance close to an outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Preheating:** Turn the appliance on using the On/Off switch. The pilot light will illuminate. Adjust the variable thermostat to your desired heat setting (1-6). The ready-to-use indicator will light up when the desired temperature is reached.

- 2. **Preparing Crepes:** Pour a small amount of crepe batter onto the center of the hot non-stick surface.
- 3. **Spreading the Batter:** Immediately use the wooden crepe turning stick to spread the batter evenly in a circular motion across the entire cooking surface.
- 4. Cooking: Cook the crepe until the edges begin to brown and the surface appears set.
- 5. **Flipping:** Use the wooden spatula to gently lift the edge of the crepe and then flip it over to cook the other side.
- 6. **Removal:** Once cooked to your preference, remove the crepe from the surface using the wooden spatula.
- 7. **Repeat:** Continue with remaining batter, adjusting the temperature as needed.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your crepe maker.

- 1. Cool Down: Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- 2. Cleaning the Cooking Surface: The non-stick coating prevents food from sticking. Simply wipe the cooled cooking surface with a soft, damp cloth or paper towel. For stubborn residue, a small amount of mild dish soap can be used, followed by wiping with a clean, damp cloth. Ensure no water enters the electrical components.
- 3. **Cleaning Accessories:** Wash the wooden spatula and turning stick with warm soapy water, rinse, and dry thoroughly.
- 4. **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior housing with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as these can damage the surface.
- 5. **Storage:** Once clean and dry, the crepe maker can be stored in a cool, dry place. Utilize the cable storage feature to keep the cord tidy.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

· Crepes sticking to the surface:

- Ensure the cooking surface is clean and free of residue.
- Make sure the appliance is fully preheated before adding batter.
- A very light coating of cooking oil or butter can be applied for the first crepe, though the nonstick surface typically does not require it.

· Uneven cooking:

- Allow sufficient preheating time for the entire surface to reach a consistent temperature.
- · Ensure the batter is spread quickly and evenly across the surface using the turning stick.

Appliance not turning on:

- · Check that the power cord is securely plugged into a working electrical outlet.
- Verify that the On/Off switch is in the 'On' position.
- · Check your household's circuit breaker or fuse box.
