## SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the scale from its packaging. Inspect for any damage.
2. **Battery Installation:** Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scale. Insert the required batteries (e.g., AAA or CR2032, refer to compartment markings) ensuring correct polarity.
3. **Placement:** Place the scale on a hard, flat, and stable surface. Avoid carpets or uneven flooring, as this can affect accuracy.
4. **Initial Calibration (First Use):** For the first use or after moving the scale, gently tap the platform with your foot to activate it, then allow it to display "0.0" or "CAL" before stepping on. This ensures proper calibration.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Step On:** Gently step onto the center of the scale platform with bare feet. The scale will automatically turn on due to its auto-on function.
2. **Stand Still:** Stand still and balanced on the scale. Your weight will be displayed on the large LCD screen.
3. **Read Measurement:** Wait for the display to stabilize and show your final weight.
4. **Auto-Off:** The scale will automatically turn off after a few seconds of inactivity to conserve battery life.

**Important:** For consistent and accurate readings, always use the scale on the same flat surface and at approximately the same time of day.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the scale surface with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the scale in water.
- **Storage:** Store the scale in a dry place at room temperature. Avoid extreme temperatures or high humidity.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the display, or if the scale becomes unresponsive. Dispose of old batteries responsibly.
- **Avoid Impact:** Do not drop the scale or subject it to heavy impact, as this may damage the internal components.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scale does not turn on.	Dead or incorrectly installed batteries.	Check battery polarity or replace batteries.
Inaccurate readings.	Scale on uneven surface; not calibrated; moved recently.	Place on a hard, flat surface. Tap to activate, wait for "0.0" before stepping on.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
"Lo" or "Err" displayed.	Low battery; overload; internal error.	Replace batteries. Ensure weight is within scale's capacity. If error persists, contact support.
