- **Extensive Car Collection:** Over 800 unique vehicle models from top manufacturers globally, with over 4,500 variations including paint configurations.
- **Diverse Tracks:** Race on over 30 famous circuits and environments optimized for the PSP.

SETUP

1. **Insert UMD:** Open the UMD drive on your Sony PSP system and carefully insert the Gran Turismo game disc. Ensure it clicks into place.
2. **Power On PSP:** Turn on your PSP system. The game should automatically load or appear in the Game menu under 'UMD'.
3. **Memory Stick Duo:** A Memory Stick Duo is required for saving game progress and other data. Ensure a compatible Memory Stick Duo with sufficient free space (minimum 256 KB for game data) is inserted into your PSP.
4. **Initial Boot:** Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, such as language selection or data installation.

OPERATING THE GAME

Basic Controls

Refer to your Sony PSP system's instruction manual for detailed information on basic button functions. In Gran Turismo, typical controls involve:

- **Analog Stick/D-Pad:** Steering
- **X Button:** Accelerate
- **Square Button:** Brake
- **Triangle/Circle Buttons:** Camera views, menu navigation
- **L/R Buttons:** Shifting gears (manual transmission), looking left/right

Gameplay Modes

Gran Turismo for PSP focuses on delivering a pure driving experience. Engage in various races and challenges to earn credits and unlock new vehicles and tracks.

- **Single Player:** Compete against AI opponents on a wide array of tracks.
- **Ad Hoc Multiplayer:** Connect wirelessly with 2-4 other PSP players to race head-to-head or engage in vehicle trading.

Vehicle Acquisition and Management

The game features a dynamic dealership system where available cars change seasonally. Explore different dealerships to find your desired vehicles. Earn credits by winning races to purchase new cars. Utilize the ad hoc mode to trade unique vehicles with friends.

MAINTENANCE

No specific maintenance is required for the Gran Turismo UMD game disc beyond standard care for optical media. Keep the UMD in its protective case when not in use to prevent scratches and dust accumulation. Clean the disc with a soft, lint-free cloth if necessary, wiping from the center outwards. For your Sony PSP system, refer to its dedicated instruction manual for maintenance guidelines.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Game Not Loading:**
 - Ensure the UMD is correctly inserted and clean.
 - Verify your PSP system is functioning correctly with other UMDs.
- **Saving Issues:**
 - Confirm a Memory Stick Duo is inserted and has sufficient free space.
 - Check if the Memory Stick Duo is write-protected.
- **Multiplayer Connection Problems:**
 - Ensure all PSP systems are within range for Ad Hoc mode.
 - Verify that Ad Hoc mode is enabled on all participating PSPs.
- **Epilepsy/Seizure Warning:** If you have a history of epilepsy or seizures, consult a doctor before using this product. Certain patterns may trigger seizures even without prior history. For more details, refer to the warning label on the product packaging.
