## 1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This document provides instructions for the Krups Dolce Gusto replacement water tank container, model MS-622080. This transparent water tank is designed to replace the original water reservoir for specific Krups Dolce Gusto coffee machine models, ensuring continued functionality of your appliance. Please note that this product is the water tank only and does not include a lid.

## 2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Before installing the new water tank, ensure your coffee machine is unplugged and cooled down. This replacement tank is designed for easy installation.

1. **Remove Old Tank (if applicable):** If replacing an existing tank, carefully lift the old water tank from its designated slot on the coffee machine. Dispose of any remaining water.
2. **Inspect New Tank:** Examine the new transparent water tank for any signs of damage or cracks from shipping.
3. **Position New Tank:** Align the new water tank with the water inlet port on your Krups Dolce Gusto machine. The tank is designed to fit snugly into place.
4. **Secure Tank:** Gently push the water tank down until it is fully seated and stable. Ensure there is no wobble and it sits flush with the machine's body.
5. **Initial Rinse:** Before first use, it is recommended to fill the tank with clean water and run a cycle without a

coffee pod to rinse the system.

### 3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the water tank is straightforward and integrated with your coffee machine's operation.

1. **Filling the Tank:** Lift the water tank from the machine or carefully pour water into the top opening while it is still on the machine. Fill with fresh, cold tap water up to the maximum fill line, if indicated on your machine. Do not overfill.
2. **Placing the Tank:** If you removed the tank for filling, ensure it is securely placed back into its position on the coffee machine.
3. **Machine Operation:** Once the tank is filled and correctly seated, you can proceed with operating your Krups Dolce Gusto coffee machine as per its original instruction manual. The machine will draw water from this tank for brewing.
4. **Monitoring Water Level:** Due to its transparent design, you can easily monitor the water level. Refill the tank before it becomes empty to avoid interrupting brewing cycles or damaging the pump.

## 4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular cleaning of the water tank is essential to maintain hygiene and ensure the best taste for your beverages.

- **Daily Cleaning:** After each use, or at least daily, empty any remaining water from the tank. Rinse it thoroughly with fresh, clean water.
- **Weekly Cleaning:** Once a week, wash the water tank with warm, soapy water. Use a soft brush or sponge to clean the interior and exterior surfaces. Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- **Drying:** Allow the water tank to air dry completely before reattaching it to the machine or storing it. This helps prevent mold and mildew growth.
- **Descaling:** The water tank itself does not require descaling, but your coffee machine will. Refer to your Krups Dolce Gusto machine's manual for descaling instructions.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals on the water tank, as these can damage the plastic and affect its transparency.

## 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your new water tank, consider the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water tank does not fit properly.	Incorrect model compatibility or misalignment.	Ensure your coffee machine model (KP2100, KP2103, KP2106, KP210610-7Z0) is listed as compatible. Re-align the tank carefully with the machine's water inlet.
Water leaks from the base of the tank.	Tank not seated correctly or damaged seal.	Remove the tank and re-seat it firmly. Check the rubber seal at the bottom of the tank for any visible damage or debris. If damaged, the tank may need replacement.
Machine not drawing water.	Tank empty, airlock, or machine issue.	Ensure the tank is filled with water. If filled, remove and re-insert the tank to clear any potential airlock. If the problem persists, refer to your coffee machine's main manual for troubleshooting pump issues.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water tastes unusual.	Tank not cleaned regularly or old water.	Empty and thoroughly clean the water tank as per maintenance instructions. Always use fresh, cold water.
