# Adesso AKB-110B Mini Keyboard User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Adesso AKB-110B Mini Keyboard. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper functionality and longevity.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- EasyTouch 110 - Mini Keyboard (Black)

- PS/2 Adapter
- Quick Start Guide

### 3. SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- Windows-based PC: Windows XP, Windows Vista, Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 10
- Available USB port or PS/2 port

### 4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to connect your Adesso AKB-110B Mini Keyboard to your computer:

1. **Power Off:** Ensure your computer is turned off before connecting the keyboard, especially if using a PS/2 connection.
2. **Connect via USB:** Plug the USB cable of the keyboard directly into an available USB port on your computer.
3. **Connect via PS/2 (Optional):** If your computer uses a PS/2 port, attach the included PS/2 adapter to the USB connector of the keyboard, then plug the PS/2 adapter into the PS/2 keyboard port on your computer.
4. **Power On:** Turn on your computer. The operating system will automatically detect and install the necessary drivers for the keyboard. No additional software installation is typically required.

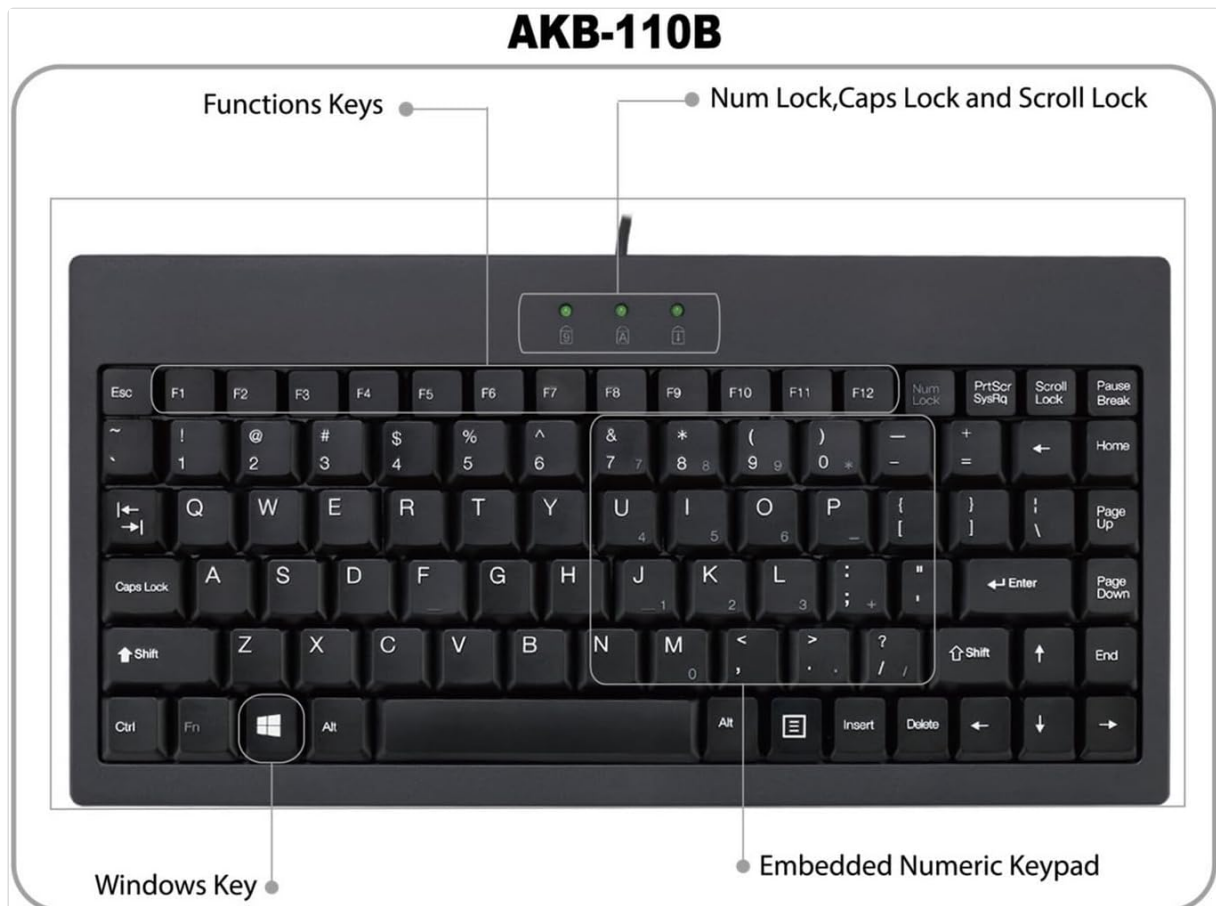


Figure 2: The underside of the keyboard showing the model number and basic installation steps for USB and PS/2 connections.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Adesso AKB-110B Mini Keyboard features a compact design with essential functionalities for efficient typing.

## 5.1 Key Layout and Features

- **87-Key Layout:** Provides a full typing experience in a space-saving form factor.
- **Embedded Numeric Keypad:** Access numeric functions by activating the Num Lock key. The numeric keys are integrated into the standard alphanumeric keys.
- **LED Indicators:** Dedicated LED lights for Num Lock, Caps Lock, and Scroll Lock are located above the function keys, indicating their active status.
- **Function Keys (F1-F12):** Standard function keys are available for various software commands.
- **Membrane Key Switches:** Designed for quiet operation and a tactile typing feel, ensuring comfort during extended use.

## 5.2 Using the Embedded Numeric Keypad

To use the embedded numeric keypad, press the **Num Lock** key. The Num Lock LED indicator will illuminate. The keys with secondary numeric or symbol functions (e.g., U, I, O, J, K, L, M) will now function as a numeric keypad. Press **Num Lock** again to return to standard alphanumeric input.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your keyboard.

- **Cleaning:** To clean the keyboard, power off your computer or disconnect the keyboard. Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the surface. For deeper cleaning, keycaps can be carefully removed (except for the spacebar) to clean underneath. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

- **Durability:** The membrane key switches are designed to withstand over 5 million keystrokes, providing reliable performance over time.
- **Storage:** Store the keyboard in a clean, dry environment away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Adesso AKB-110B Mini Keyboard, refer to the following troubleshooting steps:

- **Keyboard Not Responding:**
  - Ensure the USB or PS/2 cable is securely connected to the computer.
  - Try connecting the keyboard to a different USB or PS/2 port.
  - If using a USB hub, try connecting directly to the computer.
  - Restart your computer.
- **Keys Not Functioning Correctly:**
  - Check for any debris or obstructions under the keycaps.
  - Ensure Num Lock, Caps Lock, or Scroll Lock are not inadvertently activated if experiencing unexpected input.
- **Embedded Numeric Keypad Not Working:**
  - Press the **Num Lock** key to activate the numeric keypad function. The corresponding LED indicator should light up.
- **Compatibility Issues:**
  - Verify that your operating system is compatible with the keyboard (Windows XP, Vista, 7, 8, 10).

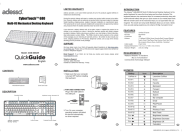
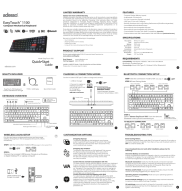
