1. SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before using the Primus Mimer Gas Stove. Failure to follow these instructions can result in serious injury, fire, or property damage.

- Outdoor Use Only: This stove is designed for outdoor use in well-ventilated areas. Never use it indoors, in a tent, or in any enclosed space, as this can lead to carbon monoxide poisoning.
- Flammable Materials: Keep the stove clear of all flammable materials, including tents, clothing, and dry vegetation.

 Maintain a safe distance from combustible surfaces.
- Hot Surfaces: The stove and surrounding areas will become extremely hot during and after use. Allow sufficient time for the stove to cool before handling or packing away. Use heat-resistant gloves if necessary.
- **Gas Cartridge Handling:** Use only gas cartridges compatible with the stove's valve type (threaded canister valves). Ensure the cartridge is securely connected before ignition. Do not puncture, incinerate, or expose gas cartridges to high temperatures.
- Children and Pets: Keep children and pets away from the stove during operation and while it is cooling down.
- Ventilation: Ensure adequate ventilation to prevent the accumulation of unburnt gas.
- Inspection: Before each use, inspect the stove and gas cartridge for any damage or leaks. Do not use if damaged.

3. SETUP

Setting up your Primus Mimer Gas Stove is quick and straightforward, allowing you to begin cooking in under a minute.

- 1. **Prepare the Area:** Choose a flat, stable, and non-flammable surface for the stove. Ensure there is adequate ventilation and no flammable materials nearby.
- 2. **Attach Gas Cartridge:** Hold the stove upright. Align the threaded connection of the stove with the valve on your gas cartridge. Screw the stove onto the cartridge clockwise until it is hand-tight. Do not overtighten.

• **Compatibility:** The Mimer stove is designed to fit threaded canister valves only. Ensure your gas cartridge has this type of valve for a secure connection.

4. OPERATION

Operating the Primus Mimer Gas Stove is simple and efficient for your outdoor cooking needs.

- 1. **Open Gas Valve:** Slowly turn the control knob on the stove counter-clockwise to open the gas valve. You should hear a faint hiss of gas.
- 2. **Ignite the Stove:** Use a match, lighter, or external piezo igniter to ignite the gas at the burner head. The Mimer stove features manual ignition.
- 3. **Adjust Flame:** Once ignited, adjust the flame to your desired intensity by turning the control knob. A blue flame indicates efficient combustion.

4. **Cooking:** Place your pot or pan on the stove's pot supports. The wide flame excels at heating larger pots, suitable for cooking for 1-3 people. For example, it can boil 1 liter of water in less than 4 minutes.

After Use:

- Turn Off Gas: Turn the control knob clockwise until the flame extinguishes completely.
- Cool Down: Allow the stove to cool down completely before handling or detaching the gas cartridge. This may take
 several minutes.
- **Detach Cartridge:** Once cool, carefully unscrew the stove from the gas cartridge.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Primus Mimer Gas Stove.

- Cleaning: After each use, ensure the stove is cool. Wipe down the stove body and pot supports with a damp cloth to remove any food residue or grime. For stubborn stains, a mild soap solution can be used. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely.
- **Burner Head:** Periodically check the burner head for any blockages or debris. Use a soft brush to gently clear any obstructions. Do not use sharp objects that could damage the burner.
- **Storage:** Store the stove in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is clean and completely dry before storage to prevent corrosion.
- **Inspection:** Regularly inspect the stove for any signs of wear, damage, or loose connections. Pay attention to the gas valve and the connection point to the cartridge. If any damage is found, do not use the stove and contact Primus customer support.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Primus Mimer Gas Stove, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

• Stove Not Igniting:

- Ensure the gas cartridge is securely attached and has sufficient fuel.
- Check that the control knob is turned sufficiently to allow gas flow.
- Verify that your ignition source (lighter, match) is working correctly and is applied directly to the burner head.

· Weak or Inconsistent Flame:

- The gas cartridge may be running low on fuel. Replace it if necessary.
- Check for blockages in the burner head or gas nozzle. Clean as described in the Maintenance section.
- Ensure the stove is not being used in extremely cold conditions, which can affect gas pressure.

• Gas Leak (Hissing Sound or Smell):

- Immediately turn off the gas flow at the control knob.
- Ensure the gas cartridge is properly and securely screwed onto the stove.
- If the leak persists, detach the cartridge in a well-ventilated area and do not use the stove. Contact Primus customer support.
