# Line 6 Spider IV 75-watt 1x12 Modeling Guitar Amplifier

## INTRODUCTION

The Line 6 Spider IV 75 guitar amplifier is designed to provide a versatile and responsive playing experience. This modeling amplifier recreates authentic characteristics and tonal nuances of various classic amplifiers, offering exceptional depth and sophisticated touch response. It delivers complex distortions and valve-style compression, enhancing each note's sustain and feel.

## SETUP

- Power Connection:** Connect the amplifier to a standard AC power outlet using the provided power cord. Ensure the amplifier's power switch is in the 'OFF' position before connecting.
- Guitar Connection:** Plug your guitar into the **1/4-inch input** jack located on the front panel.
- Foot Controller (Optional):** For enhanced control and access to advanced features, connect an FBV foot controller (e.g., FBV Express MkII, FBV Shortboard MkII) to the **FBV foot controller jack** on the rear panel. This allows for switching tones, controlling volume, wah, and other effects.
- External Audio (Optional):** For playing along with music, connect an external audio device (CD/MP3 player) to the **1/8-inch CD/MP3 input** jack.
- Headphones/Direct Output (Optional):** For silent practice or direct recording, connect headphones or a recording device to the **1/4-inch headphone/direct output**.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### Basic Controls

- **Drive Knob:** Adjusts the amount of gain or distortion.
- **Bass, Mid, Treble Knobs:** These behave like the EQ controls from each modeled amplifier, allowing for precise tonal shaping.
- **Channel Volume:** Controls the volume of the currently selected channel.
- **Master Volume:** Controls the overall output volume of the amplifier.

### Amp Models and Presets

The Spider IV 75 features 16 tonally superior amp models and over 300 hand-crafted presets from world-famous bands and guitarists, plus 200+ dialed-in song-based presets. You can also create and save up to 64 user-created presets.

## Smart FX

The amplifier includes 20 Smart FX (4 at once) with deep editing capabilities. These include Quick Loop, Auto-Wah, Intelligent Pitch-Shifter, echoes, mods, delays, and reverbs. Effects can be easily adjusted using dedicated knobs.

## Built-in Chromatic Tuner

The amplifier includes a built-in chromatic tuner for convenient and accurate tuning of your instrument.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the amplifier. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the amplifier in a dry, temperature-controlled environment away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure proper ventilation around the amplifier to prevent overheating. Do not block any vents.
- **Transportation:** When transporting the amplifier, ensure it is securely packed to prevent damage from impacts.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Sound:** Check all cable connections (guitar, power, speaker). Ensure the amplifier is powered on and volume knobs are turned up. Verify the guitar's volume is also up.
- **Distorted/Unwanted Sound:** Adjust the 'Drive' knob and 'Channel Volume'. Check for faulty cables or guitar pickups. If using an FBV controller, ensure it is properly connected and configured.
- **Foot Controller Issues:** Ensure the FBV foot controller is securely connected to the dedicated jack. If issues persist, consult the Line 6 Spider Online resources for firmware updates or troubleshooting guides.
- **Humming/Buzzing:** This can sometimes be caused by electrical interference. Try plugging the amplifier into a different power outlet or using a power conditioner. Check for loose connections.
