SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Super Mario 3D Land game:

1. Ensure your Nintendo 3DS console is powered off.
2. Open the game card slot cover on your Nintendo 3DS.
3. Insert the Super Mario 3D Land game card firmly into the slot until it clicks into place.
4. Close the game card slot cover.
5. Power on your Nintendo 3DS console. The game icon should appear on the HOME Menu.
6. Select the game icon to start playing.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Mario's Abilities:** Mario can perform a rolling somersault attack or run fast with a dash move. As Tanooki Mario, he can use his tail to hover, perform floating jumps or attacks.

- **New and Familiar Abilities:** Discover new and familiar abilities that add unique gameplay strategies to the adventure.
- **3D Visuals:** The game's 3D visuals make it easier for players to judge the depths and distances in their environments, allowing for more accurate jumps to platforms or judging distance from question blocks.
- **Circle Pad Control:** The Circle Pad provides players with complete control to confidently move Mario through fun and challenging environments.

MAINTENANCE

Game not loading or recognized by console.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Ensure the game card is fully inserted into the slot.2. Remove the game card and gently clean the gold connectors with a soft, dry cloth. Reinsert the card.3. Restart your Nintendo 3DS console.
Game freezes or crashes during gameplay.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Save your game progress if possible, then restart the console.2. Ensure your Nintendo 3DS system software is up to date.3. Check the game card for any visible damage.
Graphics or sound issues.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Adjust the 3D depth slider on your Nintendo 3DS.2. Ensure your console's volume is not muted or too low.3. Restart the game and console.
