INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the safe and effective use of your Braun Hand Blender + Chopper MR 370. Please read all instructions carefully before operating the appliance and retain this manual for future reference. The Braun MR 370 is designed for blending, chopping, mixing, and pureeing various food items in your kitchen.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed. Clean all parts that will come into contact with food according to the 'Maintenance and Cleaning' section.

Components:

- Hand Blender Motor Unit
- Blender Shaft
- Chopper Attachment (bowl, blade, lid)

Assembly:

1. **Attaching the Blender Shaft:** Align the blender shaft with the motor unit and twist until it locks securely into place.
2. **Attaching the Chopper:** Place the chopper blade onto the central pin inside the chopper bowl. Add ingredients to the bowl. Place the chopper lid onto the bowl, ensuring it is properly seated. Then, attach the motor unit to the chopper lid, twisting until it locks.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Always ensure the appliance is unplugged before assembling or disassembling parts. Do not immerse the motor unit in water.

Using the Hand Blender:

1. Attach the blender shaft to the motor unit.
2. Immerse the blender shaft into the ingredients in a pot or suitable container. Ensure the liquid level is below the connection point of the shaft and motor unit.
3. Plug the appliance into a power outlet.
4. Press and hold the power button to operate. Release the button to stop.
5. Move the blender gently up and down and in circles to ensure even blending.
6. Once blending is complete, release the button and unplug the appliance before removing it from the food.

Using the Chopper Attachment:

1. Place the chopper blade in the chopper bowl.
 2. Add ingredients to the chopper bowl. Do not overfill.
 3. Secure the chopper lid and attach the motor unit.
 4. Plug the appliance into a power outlet.
 5. Press and hold the power button in short pulses for chopping. For finer results, continue pulsing.
 6. Release the button and unplug the appliance before disassembling and removing chopped ingredients.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Proper cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your appliance.

Cleaning:

- **Motor Unit:** Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth. Never immerse it in water or other liquids.
- **Blender Shaft and Chopper Parts:** These parts can be rinsed under running water immediately after use. For thorough cleaning, they are generally dishwasher-safe (refer to specific product instructions if available, otherwise hand wash is recommended).
- **Blades:** Handle blades with extreme care as they are very sharp.

Storage:

Store the appliance and its attachments in a dry, safe place, out of reach of children.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Braun Hand Blender + Chopper MR 370, refer to the following common problems

and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet issue; motor unit not properly attached.	Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check if the motor unit is correctly locked onto the attachment.
Poor blending/chopping performance.	Too much food; ingredients too large; dull blade.	Reduce the quantity of ingredients. Cut larger ingredients into smaller pieces. Ensure the blade is clean and free of debris.
Appliance stops during operation.	Overheating; motor overload.	Unplug the appliance and allow it to cool down for at least 30 minutes. Reduce the load or processing time.
