INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of Spectracide Triazicide Insect Killer for Lawns & Landscapes Concentrate (Ready-To-Spray). This fast-acting formula protects lawns, vegetables, fruit and nut trees, roses, flowers, trees, and shrubs. It kills over 260 listed insects by contact, both above and below ground, including grubs, most ants, fleas, deer ticks, and Japanese beetles. The formula is non-staining to most home siding, depending on age and cleanliness. This product is designed for easy application with its QuickFlip spray concentrate that attaches directly to your garden hose.

HOW TO USE

1. Shake well before using.
2. Connect a garden hose to the sprayer nozzle. Make sure switch is fully forward in the "OFF" position.
3. Turn on water at faucet. Extend hose to the farthest area to be treated and work back toward the faucet so you don't come in contact with the treated area.
4. Remove safety tab from sprayer's right side by pulling straight out. Discard or keep for future reuse.
5. To begin spraying, point nozzle toward treatment site and pull switch backward toward hose connection. Water will automatically mix with the product. Spray until wet to control insects.
6. Walk at a steady pace, working back toward the faucet while spraying, using an even sweeping motion, slightly overlapping treated areas.
7. To stop spraying, push switch forward with thumb toward nozzle. Turn water off at faucet. To relieve pressure before removing nozzle from hose, pull switch backwards with thumb toward hose connection until water stops spraying.
8. Reinstall safety tab into sprayer's right side. With sprayer in the full "OFF" position, push tab into position.

SETUP AND APPLICATION

Preparing for Application

Ensure the area to be treated is ready. For lawns, it is recommended to thoroughly wet down the grass a few hours before applying the product. This helps in optimal absorption and effectiveness.

Hose-End Sprayer Instructions

1. **Shake well** before using.
2. **Connect a garden hose** to the sprayer nozzle. Ensure the switch is fully forward in the "OFF" position.
3. **Turn on water** at the faucet. Extend the hose to the farthest area to be treated and work back toward the faucet to avoid contact with the treated area.
4. **Remove safety tab** from the sprayer's right side by pulling straight out. Discard or keep for future reuse.

Where to Use

This concentrate formula is suitable for controlling pests in lawns and landscapes, vegetable and flower gardens, and around roses, trees, and shrubs. Begin treating when insects first appear.

Coverage

One 32 fl oz bottle of this ready-to-spray product covers up to 5,120 square feet of lawn for lawn surface insects.

DETERMINE WHICH PRODUCT IS RIGHT FOR THE JOB:

LIQUIDS

Can be used for large areas or as a spot treatment to kill insects on lawns and landscapes.

Application methods

Hose-End Sprayer:

Use to treat large areas. Simple hose-end attachment with no pre-mixing required.



Ready-To-Use:

Features handle and sprayer attachment. Ideal for spot treatment. No mixing required.



Concentrate:

Ideal for use with a tank sprayer to treat large areas. Must be mixed with water as directed.



GRANULES

Great for treating lawn-invading insects in large areas such as lawns and for spot treatment

Application methods

Broadcast:

Best for treating large areas, such as lawns, with a broadcast spreader.



Spot Treatment: Best for smaller areas such as landscape beds or in problem areas.

MAINTENANCE

For optimal control of surface insects, delay additional watering or mowing for 24 hours after application. Do not apply more than 14 times per year per location. For fire ant mounds, apply in cool weather (65°F to 80°F) or in the early morning or late evening for best results.

Storage

Store the product in its original container in a cool, dry place, inaccessible to children and pets. Keep from freezing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Ineffective Treatment

- **Check application rate:** Ensure you are applying the product at the recommended rate for the specific pest and area size.
- **Weather conditions:** Avoid applying during heavy rain or strong winds, which can reduce effectiveness

or cause runoff.

- **Timing:** Apply when insects are most active or when damage is first noticed. For some pests like fire ants, specific temperature ranges are recommended.
- **Watering:** For surface insects, ensure the lawn is wet a few hours before application and avoid watering for 24 hours after. For subsurface insects, light watering immediately after application may be necessary to carry the product into the soil.

Sprayer Issues

- **No spray or weak spray:** Ensure the hose is properly connected and the faucet is fully open. Check that the safety tab is fully removed and the switch is in the correct "ON" position for spraying.
- **Leaks:** Verify all connections are tight.

Do not apply this product or allow it to drift to blooming crops or weeds if bees are visiting the treatment area.
