### 3. COMPATIBILITY

### 4. SETUP & INSTALLATION

#### Installation Steps:

1. **Preparation:** Gather necessary tools such as a small screwdriver, shock oil (if refilling), and a clean cloth. Ensure your workspace is clean and organized.
2. **Disassembly:** Carefully remove the existing shock caps from your Ultra Shocks. Be mindful of shock oil and internal components like O-rings and diaphragms.
3. **Inspection:** Inspect the shock shafts, O-rings, and other internal components for any signs of wear, damage, or deformation. Replace any worn parts to ensure optimal performance.
4. **Filling (if applicable):** If you are refilling or replacing shock oil, ensure the proper oil weight and fill level are used according to your vehicle's specifications. Avoid air bubbles in the shock fluid.
5. **Installation:** Place the new Traxxas 3767A aluminum shock caps onto the shock bodies. Ensure they are seated correctly and tighten them securely. **Do not overtighten**, as this can damage the threads or the cap itself.
6. **Testing:** After installation, gently compress and extend the shocks several times to check for smooth operation, proper damping, and to ensure there are no oil leaks.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once installed, the Traxxas 3767A Aluminum Shock Caps function as direct replacements for the stock plastic caps, providing enhanced durability and a secure seal for your Ultra Shocks during vehicle operation. They are designed to withstand impacts and prevent oil leakage under normal operating conditions, contributing to consistent suspension performance.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular inspection and maintenance of your shock caps and shocks are recommended to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your Traxxas vehicle.

- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically check the aluminum shock caps for any signs of damage, such as dents, cracks, or a loose fit.
- **Leak Detection:** Look for any oil leakage around the shock caps or shock bodies, which may indicate a compromised seal or damaged O-rings.
- **Cleaning:** Keep the shock caps and surrounding areas clean from dirt, mud, and debris. This helps prevent abrasive wear on O-rings and threads.
- **O-Ring Replacement:** If oil leaks are observed, it is often necessary to replace the internal O-rings as part of routine shock maintenance. Refer to your vehicle's manual for the correct O-ring sizes and replacement procedures.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are some common issues and their potential solutions related to shock caps:

- **Shock Cap Popping Off:**
  - Ensure the shock caps are tightened securely but not excessively.
  - Verify that the internal O-rings are correctly seated and not damaged.
  - Over-pressurized shocks (due to too much oil or air) or extreme impacts can sometimes cause caps to dislodge. Check shock oil levels and consider softer springs if this is a recurring issue.
- **Oil Leakage:**
  - Check for proper seating of the shock cap on the shock body.
  - Inspect the condition of the internal O-rings. Replace worn, cracked, or flattened O-rings if necessary.
  - Ensure the shock shaft is not bent or scratched, as this can also lead to leaks.
