EyePet - PlayStation 3 Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

EyePet is a unique interactive virtual pet game for the PlayStation 3. It allows players to bring a digital pet into their living room using the PlayStation Eye camera and PlayStation Move motion controller. Players can interact with their EyePet, customize its appearance, and engage in various activities and games, fostering a bond with their virtual companion.

KEY FEATURES

- **Interactive Pet:** EyePet reacts to every movement and command, responding to petting, tickling, and playing with toys.
- **Extensive Customization:** Modify EyePet's fur length, color, and pattern, and choose from over 250 unique outfits and accessories to personalize its look.
- **Creative Play:** Draw new toys in the real world and watch them transform into three-dimensional in-game objects for your EyePet to interact with.
- **Share Experiences:** Record your favorite EyePet moments and creations, then share them online with friends and other players.

SETUP

Required Equipment

- PlayStation 3 console (any model: original, Slim, Super Slim)
- PlayStation Eye camera (sold separately)
- PlayStation Move motion controller (sold separately)
- EyePet game disc

Installation

Insert the EyePet game disc into your PlayStation 3 console. Follow the on-screen prompts to install the game data onto your console's hard drive. A minimum of 256MB of hard drive space is required for installation.

Camera Setup

Connect the PlayStation Eye camera to a USB port on your PlayStation 3 console. Position the camera in a central location, typically above or below your television, ensuring it has a clear, unobstructed view of your play area. Good lighting is essential for optimal tracking performance.

Controller Pairing

Turn on your PlayStation Move motion controller and pair it with your PlayStation 3 console according to the PS3 system instructions. Ensure the controller is fully charged for uninterrupted gameplay.

OPERATING YOUR EYEPET

Starting the Game

From the PlayStation 3 XMB (XrossMediaBar) menu, navigate to the 'Game' section and select the EyePet icon to launch the game.

Interacting with EyePet

Once the game starts, your EyePet will appear virtually in your living room. Use the PlayStation Move motion controller to interact. The controller acts as a magical wand, transforming into various tools and toys on screen. EyePet will respond to your movements and even voice commands, creating a dynamic and engaging experience.



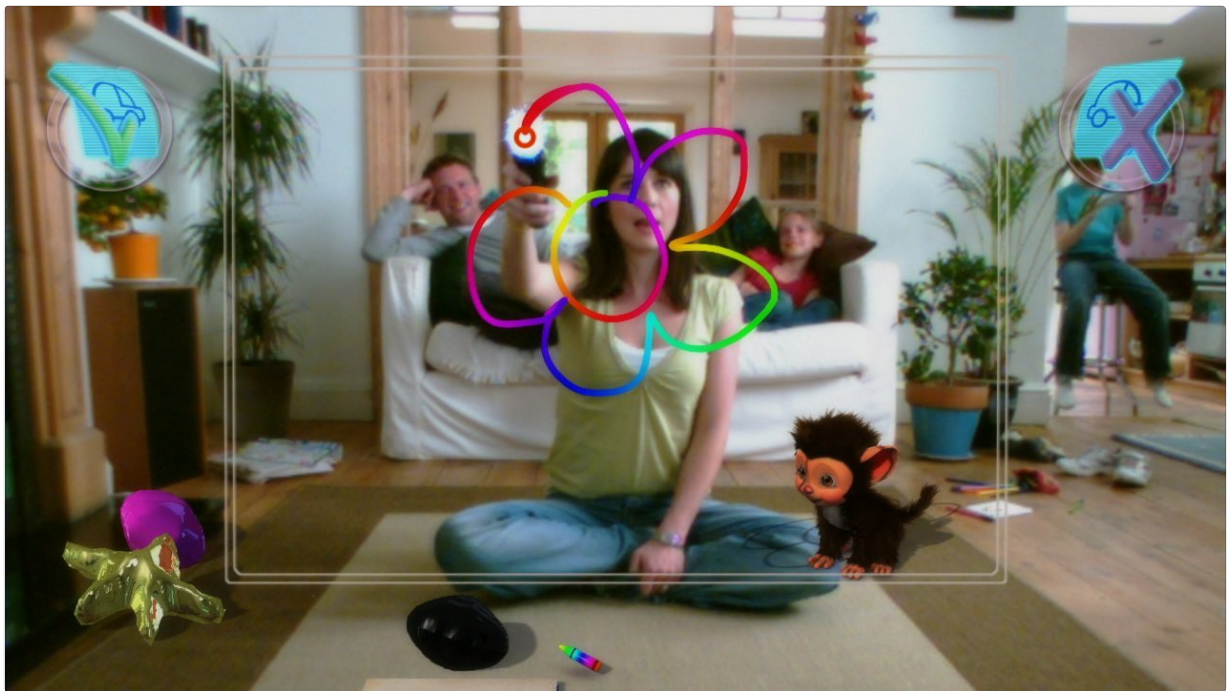

Caring for Your EyePet

Your EyePet has needs that you must attend to. The game provides visual cues and indicators to show when your pet needs food, exercise, or creative stimulation. Fulfilling these needs will help your EyePet grow and develop.

Customization

Access the customization menu to change your EyePet's appearance. You can alter its fur length, color, and pattern, and dress it in a wide variety of outfits and accessories. Experiment with different styles to make your EyePet unique.

Drawing and Creating

One of EyePet's unique features is the ability to bring your drawings to life. Use the PlayStation Move controller to draw shapes and objects on a piece of paper or directly on the screen. These drawings will magically transform into 3D toys that your EyePet can play with.

pictures of your EyePet's antics and share them online with friends and the EyePet community.

MAINTENANCE

Pet Care

Regularly attend to your EyePet's needs to ensure its well-being. This includes feeding it, grooming its fur (e.g., bathing and drying), and engaging in play. A happy EyePet is a responsive EyePet.

Game Data Management

Periodically check your PlayStation 3's hard drive space to ensure there is enough room for game saves, updates, and any additional downloadable content for EyePet. The game requires 256MB for initial installation.

Physical Maintenance

Keep the lens of your PlayStation Eye camera clean and free from dust or smudges. A clean lens ensures accurate tracking of your movements and the PlayStation Move controller.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Tracking Issues

If you experience inconsistent tracking of your movements or the PlayStation Move controller, ensure your play area is well-lit and free from strong glare or shadows. Verify that the PlayStation Eye camera lens is clean and positioned correctly to capture the entire play space.

Game Performance

Should the game freeze or crash, try restarting your PlayStation 3 console. Ensure your PS3 system

software is updated to the latest version. If problems persist, consider reinstalling the EyePet game data.

Controller Connectivity

If your PlayStation Move controller is not responding, check its battery level and ensure it is properly paired with your PlayStation 3. Refer to your PS3 system manual for detailed controller pairing instructions.
