## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your RCA DRC69705 7-Inch Dual Screen Mobile DVD System. Designed for portable entertainment, this system features a main DVD player unit and an additional screen, allowing multiple viewers to enjoy movies on the go. The system includes electronic skip protection for smooth playback, built-in stereo speakers, headphone jacks, and AV input/output jacks for versatile connectivity. Please read this manual thoroughly to ensure proper use and longevity of your device.

## SETUP

### Package Contents

- Main 7-inch DVD Player Unit
- Additional 7-inch Screen
- Remote Control
- Car Power Adapter
- AV Power Cable
- 2 Headrest Mounting Kits

### Mounting the Screens

The system includes two headrest mounting kits for secure installation in a vehicle. Attach each screen to a headrest using the provided straps, ensuring they are firmly secured and positioned for optimal viewing by passengers. The straps are designed to fit around most standard car headrests.

## Connecting the System

- Connect the Screens:** Use the supplied AV power cable to connect the main DVD player unit to the additional screen. This cable transmits both video and audio signals between the two displays.
- Power Connection:** Plug the car power adapter into the main DVD player unit's power input. Then, insert the car power adapter into your vehicle's 12V cigarette lighter socket. The system is designed to draw power from the vehicle's electrical system.
- External Device Connection (Optional):** The main unit features AV input and output jacks. These can be used to connect external video game systems, camcorders, or other AV products for display on the screens.

## OPERATING YOUR DVD SYSTEM

### Inserting a DVD

- Gently press the OPEN button on the main DVD player unit to open the disc tray.
- Carefully place a DVD disc onto the spindle with the label side facing up.
- Close the disc tray firmly until it clicks into place. The system will automatically begin reading the disc.

### Basic Controls

The main DVD player unit features integrated control buttons for essential functions:

- Play/Pause:** Initiates or temporarily stops playback.

- **Stop:** Halts playback and returns to the disc's main menu or beginning.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Skips through content quickly.
- **Skip (Next/Previous):** Jumps to the next or previous chapter/track.

A remote control is also included for convenient operation from a distance. Ensure a clear line of sight between the remote and the main unit's infrared receiver.

## Using Headphones

Both the main DVD player unit and the additional screen are equipped with headphone jacks. This allows individual viewers to listen to audio privately without disturbing others. Simply plug standard 3.5mm headphones into the designated jack on either screen.

## Adjusting Volume

Volume can be adjusted directly on the main DVD player unit using the dedicated volume controls. The remote control also provides volume adjustment functionality.

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the units. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Disc Handling:** Always handle DVDs by their edges to avoid fingerprints and scratches. Store discs in their cases when not in use.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the DVD system in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Cables:** Ensure all cables are not kinked or pinched, which can lead to damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Power	Car power adapter not properly connected or vehicle's 12V socket is not active.	Ensure the car power adapter is securely plugged into both the DVD unit and the vehicle's 12V socket. Check vehicle's ignition or fuse for the 12V socket.
No Picture/Sound	AV cable between units is loose or damaged; disc is dirty or damaged.	Check all cable connections. Clean the DVD disc with a soft cloth or try a different disc. Ensure volume is not muted or too low.
Disc Skipping	Disc is scratched or dirty; excessive vehicle vibration.	Clean the disc. While the system has electronic skip protection, extreme bumps may still cause skipping. Ensure the units are securely mounted.
Remote Control Not Working	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted; no clear line of sight.	Replace remote control batteries. Ensure batteries are inserted with correct polarity. Point the remote directly at the main unit's IR sensor.




