INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient installation, operation, and maintenance of your Advance Tabco Stainless Steel Utility Sink, Model 4-81-18. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and use, and retain it for future reference.

This utility sink is designed for commercial use and features a single compartment, 16-gauge 430 stainless steel construction, and includes a basket drain.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Always observe basic safety precautions when installing, operating, or performing maintenance on this product.

- Ensure all local plumbing and building codes are followed during installation.
- Wear appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) such as gloves and safety glasses during installation and maintenance.
- Do not overload the sink. Refer to specifications for weight limits.
- Keep the area around the sink clear to prevent tripping hazards.
- Verify the stability of the installed unit before use.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

This section outlines the steps for assembling and installing your utility sink.

Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect all parts for any damage that may have occurred during shipping. Report any damage to the carrier immediately.

Components

- Sink Bowl Assembly (with back splash)
- Legs (typically 4)
- Adjustable Bullet Feet
- Basket Drain

Assembly Steps

1. **Attach Legs:** Securely attach the four legs to the designated mounting points on the underside of the sink bowl assembly. Ensure all fasteners are tightened appropriately.
2. **Install Adjustable Feet:** Thread the adjustable bullet feet into the bottom of each leg. These feet allow for leveling the sink on uneven surfaces.
3. **Install Basket Drain:** Insert the included basket drain into the drain opening of the sink bowl. Follow the manufacturer's instructions for the drain assembly to ensure a watertight seal.

Placement and Leveling

Position the assembled sink in its desired location. Use a spirit level to ensure the sink is perfectly level by adjusting the bullet feet. Proper leveling is crucial for efficient drainage.

Plumbing Connections

Connect the sink's drain outlet to the building's wastewater system according to local plumbing codes. If a faucet is to be installed (sink comes without faucet), connect water supply lines to the faucet mounting centers (8 inches) and then to the building's hot and cold water supply.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Advance Tabco Utility Sink is designed for straightforward operation.

- **Water Supply:** If a faucet is installed, turn on the water supply to the desired temperature and flow.
- **Drainage:** The sink is equipped with a basket drain to prevent large debris from entering the plumbing system. Ensure the basket is in place during use.
- **Usage:** Use the sink for general utility purposes, such as washing tools, cleaning supplies, or disposing of non-hazardous liquids.
- **Avoid Overfilling:** Do not fill the sink beyond its capacity to prevent spills and potential damage.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Regular cleaning and maintenance will prolong the life and appearance of your stainless steel utility sink.

Daily Cleaning

- After each use, rinse the sink thoroughly with clean water.
- Wipe down all stainless steel surfaces with a soft cloth and a mild detergent or stainless steel cleaner.
- Dry the sink completely to prevent water spots and mineral buildup.

Preventing Stains and Corrosion

- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, steel wool, or harsh chemicals (e.g., bleach, strong acids) as they can damage the stainless steel finish.
- Promptly clean up any spills, especially those involving acidic foods or chemicals.
- Regularly clean the basket drain to prevent clogs and odors.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your utility sink.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water drains slowly.	Clogged basket drain or plumbing.	Clean the basket drain. If the issue persists, check the plumbing for blockages.
Sink is wobbly.	Uneven floor or loose leg connections.	Adjust the bullet feet to level the sink. Ensure all leg fasteners are tight.
Water spots or streaks on stainless steel.	Hard water deposits or improper drying.	Wipe dry after each use. Use a stainless steel cleaner for stubborn spots.
