Introduction

The Stadler Form Oskar humidifier is an energy-saving evaporative humidifier designed to improve room air quality. It features an integrated hygrostat for precise humidification, quiet operation, and dimmable LEDs for night mode. The unit also includes a memo function to remind you when to change filters and supports aroma diffusion.

- **Healthy Room Air:** Provides precise humidification for rooms up to 540 square feet, combating dry air conditions.
- **Energy-Saving:** Operates economically with automatic switch-off when the water tank is empty, reducing power consumption.
- **Quiet Night Mode:** Designed for bedrooms with minimal noise and dimmable LEDs for undisturbed sleep.
- **Memo Function:** Reminds users to change the humidifier wicks for optimal performance.
- **Aroma Diffusion:** Includes a fragrance dispenser for adding essential oils.
- **Output Levels:** Features two adjustable output levels.
- **Capacity:** Maximum output of 1.9 gallons per day with a 0.8-gallon tank capacity.

Setup

Follow these steps to set up your Stadler Form Oskar humidifier for the first time.


1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. **Install Filters:** Open the top cover of the humidifier and insert the two humidifier wicks into their designated slots. Ensure they are properly seated.
3. **Fill Water Tank:** Open the side flap and fill the water tank with clean tap water. Do not exceed the 'MAX' fill line.
4. **Placement:** Place the humidifier on a flat, stable surface in the desired room. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit for air circulation.
5. **Power On:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The unit is now ready for operation.



Operating Instructions

Understand how to use your Oskar humidifier effectively.

1. **Power On/Off:** Press the power button to turn the unit on or off.
2. **Set Humidity Level:** Use the hygrostat control to select your desired humidity level. The humidifier will automatically maintain this level.
3. **Adjust Output:** Select one of the two available output levels to control the humidification intensity.
4. **Night Mode / Dimmable LEDs:** Activate night mode to dim or turn off the LED indicator lights for undisturbed sleep.
5. **Aroma Diffusion:** Open the small aroma dispenser compartment (usually a pull-out tray) and add a few drops of essential oil to the aroma pad. Close the compartment.
6. **Water Refill:** The humidifier can be refilled during operation by opening the side flap and pouring water directly into the tank.

Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your humidifier.

- **Humidifier Wick Replacement:** The memo function will indicate when it's time to replace the humidifier

wicks. Typically, wicks should be replaced every 2-3 months, depending on water quality and usage.

- **Water Cube Replacement:** Replace the Water Cube every 1-2 months to maintain water hygiene and prevent bacterial growth.
- **Water Tank Cleaning:** Clean the water tank weekly with a mild detergent and rinse thoroughly.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, damp cloth as needed.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your Oskar humidifier, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

- **No Humidification:** Check if the water tank is empty. Ensure the humidifier wicks are properly installed and saturated with water. Verify the power connection.
- **Low Output:** Replace old or clogged humidifier wicks. Ensure the fan is operating correctly. Check for proper water level.
- **Unusual Noise:** Ensure the unit is on a flat, stable surface. Check for any obstructions in the fan area. Clean the unit to remove mineral buildup.
- **Indicator Lights Not Working:** Check power connection. If in night mode, LEDs may be dimmed or off. Adjust settings.
