SETUP

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These scissors are designed for ambidextrous use, though the ergonomic handle may feel more natural in the right hand for some users. The SoftGrip handles provide enhanced comfort and control.

1. **Grip:** Place your thumb through the smaller top loop and your fingers through the larger bottom loop. The SoftGrip material will conform to your hand for a comfortable hold.
2. **Positioning:** Hold the material to be cut firmly with one hand. Position the scissors so the blades are aligned with your desired cutting line.
3. **Cutting:** Gently squeeze the handles together to close the blades, making a clean cut. Release the handles to open the blades and repeat the motion for continuous cutting.
4. **Material Compatibility:**
 - **Paper & Cardboard:** Ideal for various paper weights, including construction paper, cardstock, and light cardboard.
 - **Light Fabric:** Suitable for cutting light fabrics for crafts or minor alterations.
 - **Wrapping Paper:** Provides clean, crisp edges for gift wrapping.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity and performance of your Fiskars scissors.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe blades with a soft, damp cloth after each use, especially if cutting materials with adhesive or residue. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.
- **Storage:** Store scissors in a dry place, preferably with blades closed, to protect the cutting edge and prevent accidental injury.
- **Sharpening:** While the stainless steel blades are designed to stay sharp, professional sharpening may be considered if performance significantly diminishes over time. Avoid attempting to sharpen blades with household tools unless specifically designed for scissors.
- **Avoid Misuse:** Do not use these scissors for heavy-duty tasks such as cutting wire, thick cardboard, or metal, as this can damage the blades and void the warranty.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Fiskars scissors, consider the following:

- **Dull Blades:** If blades feel dull, ensure they are clean. Sticky residue can sometimes mimic dullness. If still dull, consider professional sharpening or contact customer support regarding the lifetime warranty.
- **Sticky Blades:** Clean blades thoroughly with a damp cloth and mild soap if necessary, then dry completely. For stubborn adhesive, a small amount of rubbing alcohol on a cloth can be used, followed by drying.
- **Loose Pivot:** The pivot screw is factory-set. If it feels excessively loose, contact Fiskars customer support. Do not attempt to tighten it yourself unless you have the proper tools and knowledge, as overtightening can damage the scissors.


