INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your Satco A3925 G16.5 Incandescent Light Bulb. Please read these instructions carefully before installation and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always turn off power to the fixture before installing or removing the bulb.
- Do not exceed the maximum wattage rating of your fixture.
- Handle bulbs carefully; glass can break.
- This bulb is designed for indoor use in dry locations.
- Allow the bulb to cool completely before handling after use.

SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- 1. **Verify Compatibility:** Ensure your light fixture has an E12 candelabra base and is rated for 25 watts or higher.
- 2. **Power Off:** Before installation, turn off the power to the light fixture at the circuit breaker or wall switch.
- 3. **Unpack Bulb:** Carefully remove the new Satco A3925 bulb from its packaging.
- 4. **Install Bulb:** Gently screw the bulb into the E12 candelabra base socket until it is snug. Do not overtighten.
- 5. **Restore Power:** Turn the power back on at the circuit breaker or wall switch.
- 6. **Test:** Turn on the light switch to confirm the bulb is working correctly.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Satco A3925 G16.5 incandescent bulb operates like a standard light bulb. Simply use the wall switch or fixture control to turn the light on or off. This bulb provides a warm white light at 2700K and 162 lumens.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Ensure the power is off and the bulb is cool before cleaning. Wipe the bulb with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners.
- **Replacement:** When the bulb reaches the end of its life (approximately 2500 average rated hours), replace it with a new Satco A3925 G16.5 25-watt incandescent bulb or an equivalent. Follow the installation steps for replacement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Bulb flickers.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Loose connection.◦ Incompatible dimmer switch (if applicable).◦ Bulb nearing end of life.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">◦ Tighten the bulb.◦ Ensure dimmer is compatible with incandescent bulbs.◦ Replace the bulb.
