For proper fit, measure your RV including bumpers, ladder, and spare tire, but exclude ground clearance and the hitch. The cover is designed to accommodate roof-top accessories such as air conditioning units.

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Trailer:** Ensure all sharp edges on your trailer are padded to prevent tearing the cover. This includes corners, gutters, and any protruding accessories.
2. **Unfold the Cover:** Lay the cover out flat, ideally on a clean surface near your trailer, identifying the front and rear sections.
3. **Position the Cover:** Drape the cover over the top of your pop-up trailer, aligning the front and rear sections correctly. The elasticized corners should help guide the initial placement.
4. **Adjust for Fit:** Gently pull the cover down over the sides of the trailer. Utilize the front/rear rope cinching system to remove any excess slack, ensuring a tight fit around the trailer's body.
5. **Secure Straps:** Fasten the bottom-mounted strap/buckle system underneath the trailer. Tighten these straps to prevent the cover from lifting or flapping in windy conditions.
6. **Final Adjustments:** Check all corners and edges to ensure the cover is evenly distributed and securely fastened. The reinforced corners provide extra durability at these stress points.

OPERATING THE COVER

Once installed, the ADCO SFS Aqua Shed Cover provides continuous protection. The breathable material ensures proper air circulation, minimizing condensation and potential mildew growth. The water-beading top panel and polypropylene sides work together to repel rain and protect against UV rays.

Tips for Optimal Performance:

- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect the cover for any loose straps or signs of wear, especially after strong winds or heavy precipitation.
- **Maintain Tension:** Ensure the cinching system and bottom straps remain taut to prevent wind from getting underneath and damaging the cover or trailer.

MAINTENANCE

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Wind Damage/Looseness:** If the cover appears loose or is flapping in the wind, re-tighten all cinching ropes and bottom straps. Ensure the elasticized corners are properly seated.
- **Moisture Underneath:** While the cover is breathable, excessive condensation can occur in certain conditions. Ensure the trailer is completely dry before covering. Verify that the cover is not too tight, which could restrict airflow.
- **Material Degradation:** Over time, exposure to harsh UV rays can degrade the material. Regular inspection and proper storage when not in use can extend the cover's lifespan.
