INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Little Tikes 2-in-1 Scooter. This product is designed to grow with your child, converting from a foot-to-floor ride-on for younger children to a stand-up scooter for older children. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure safe operation and proper maintenance.

Safety Information

- **WARNING:** Adult assembly required.
- **WARNING:** Always supervise children during use.
- **WARNING:** Protective equipment such as a helmet, knee pads, and elbow pads should be worn.
- Do not use in traffic.
- Recommended for ages 18 months to 3 years.
- Maximum weight capacity: 23 kg (50 lbs).
- Inspect the scooter before each use for loose parts or damage. Do not use if damaged.
- Ensure all locking mechanisms are securely fastened before use.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

The Little Tikes 2-in-1 Scooter can be assembled in two configurations: a ride-on mode and a stand-up scooter mode. The scooter features a wide base with four wheels for stability in both modes.

Mode 1: Ride-On Assembly (for younger children)

1. Ensure the Scooter Base is placed on a flat, stable surface.
2. Insert the Handlebar Assembly into the designated slot on the Scooter Base. Push down firmly until it clicks into place.
3. Slide the Seat onto the handlebar post. Adjust the height as needed and secure it with the locking mechanism. Ensure the seat is stable and does not wobble.
4. Verify all connections are secure before use.

Mode 2: Stand-Up Scooter Assembly (for older children)

1. If the scooter is currently in ride-on mode, remove the Seat by disengaging its locking mechanism and sliding it off

the handlebar post.

2. Ensure the Handlebar Assembly is securely inserted into the Scooter Base. The handlebar height can be adjusted by pressing the release button and sliding the handlebar up or down to the desired position. Release the button to lock it in place.
3. Verify that all wheels are securely attached and spin freely.

Always double-check all connections and locking mechanisms before allowing a child to use the scooter in either mode.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using as a Ride-On

- Ensure the seat is at an appropriate height for the child to comfortably reach the ground with their feet.
- The child should sit on the seat and use their feet to push off the ground, propelling the ride-on forward.
- Steering is achieved by turning the handlebars.
- Always ensure the child is wearing appropriate safety gear.

Using as a Stand-Up Scooter

- Ensure the seat is removed and the handlebar is adjusted to a comfortable height for the child to stand and hold.
- The child should place one foot on the scooter deck and use the other foot to push off the ground.
- Steering is achieved by leaning and turning the handlebars.
- To stop, the child can place their pushing foot on the ground or use the front braking mechanism.
- Always ensure the child is wearing appropriate safety gear, including a helmet.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the scooter clean with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- **Storage:** Store the scooter indoors in a dry place when not in use to prevent damage from weather exposure.
- **Inspection:** Regularly check all screws, nuts, and bolts to ensure they are tight. Inspect wheels for wear and tear.
- **Lubrication:** No lubrication is typically required for this product.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Scooter feels unstable.	Loose connections; improper assembly.	Check all screws and bolts. Ensure handlebar and seat (if in ride-on mode) are securely locked in place. Re-read assembly instructions.
Wheels do not spin freely.	Debris in wheel mechanism; damaged wheel.	Remove any debris from around the wheels. If a wheel is damaged, contact customer service for replacement parts.
Seat is difficult to adjust or remove.	Locking mechanism stuck or misaligned.	Ensure the release button or lever is fully engaged. Apply gentle, even pressure. Do not force.
