1. INTRODUCTION

The Marina I25 Internal Filter is designed for efficient water filtration in aquariums up to 6.6 US gallons (25 liters). Its compact design and quiet operation make it suitable for goldfish and tropical tanks. This manual provides instructions for setup, operation, and maintenance to ensure optimal performance and clear aquarium water.

2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The Marina I25 Internal Filter package includes the following items:

- Marina I25 Internal Filter Unit
- One (1) Power Cartridge
- Suction Cups for mounting

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove the Marina I25 Internal Filter and all its components from the packaging.
2. **Insert Power Cartridge:** Ensure the power cartridge is correctly inserted into the filter unit. The cartridge is uniquely designed for water to enter its center for optimal filtration.
3. **Mount the Filter:** Attach the filter securely to the inside wall of your aquarium using the provided suction cups. For compatible Marina goldfish aquariums, it can also be clipped onto the tank rim.

4. **Submerge Filter:** Position the filter so that it is fully submerged in water. The motor is designed to operate underwater for exceptionally quiet performance.
5. **Connect Power:** Connect the power cord to a suitable electrical outlet. Always ensure a drip loop is formed in the power cord to prevent water from traveling along the cord and reaching the electrical outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Once powered on, the Marina I25 Internal Filter begins its multi-stage filtration process:

- Water enters the center of the power cartridge.
- The first stage involves a zeolite chamber, which effectively removes toxic ammonia from the water.
- The second stage utilizes activated carbon to eliminate pollutants and odors, improving water clarity and quality.
- Finally, floating debris is trapped within the cartridge, ensuring your aquarium water remains crystal clear.

The submerged motor design contributes to the filter's exceptionally quiet operation, minimizing disturbance to your aquatic environment.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance of your Marina I25 Internal Filter is crucial for maintaining optimal water quality and filter efficiency.

- **Power Cartridge Replacement:** The power cartridge should be replaced regularly to ensure continuous effective filtration. The cartridge change process is designed to be fast and mess-free. Refer to the product packaging or the official PDF manual for recommended replacement frequency, typically every 2-4 weeks depending on tank load.
- **Filter Unit Cleaning:** Periodically, the filter unit itself may require cleaning to remove accumulated debris. Always disconnect the power before performing any cleaning. Rinse the filter unit and impeller under aquarium water (not tap water, to preserve beneficial bacteria) to remove any buildup.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Marina I25 Internal Filter, consider the following common solutions:

- **Reduced Water Flow:**
 - Check if the power cartridge is clogged and requires replacement.
 - Ensure the impeller is clean and free of obstructions.
 - Verify the filter is fully submerged in water.
- **Excessive Noise:**
 - Ensure the filter is fully submerged and securely mounted.
 - Check the impeller for any debris or damage that might cause vibration.

- **Cloudy Water:**

- This may indicate a need for cartridge replacement.
- Ensure proper tank cycling and regular partial water changes in addition to filter maintenance.
- Avoid overfeeding your fish.
