# BestPet 4-Wheel Folding Pet Stroller Instruction Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the BestPet 4-Wheel Folding Pet Stroller. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your pet stroller. Please read these instructions thoroughly before use to ensure the safety and comfort of your pet. This stroller is designed for transporting small to medium-sized pets, offering a convenient way to take your companion on walks, errands, or travel.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Always prioritize your pet's safety. Adhere to the following guidelines:

- **Maximum Weight Capacity:** Do not exceed the maximum weight recommendation of 35 pounds (15.8 kg). Overloading can compromise stability and safety.
- **Secure Your Pet:** Always use the internal safety harness (5-point harness type) to secure your pet inside the stroller. This prevents accidental falls or escapes.
- **Brake Engagement:** Engage the rear wheel brakes when the stroller is stationary to prevent unintended movement.
- **Supervision:** Never leave your pet unattended in the stroller, especially on inclines or near traffic.
- **Assembly:** Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and locked into place before placing your pet inside.
- **Terrain:** While the stroller is designed for various terrains, exercise caution on uneven or rough surfaces to avoid tipping.

- **Weather Conditions:** Protect your pet from extreme weather. The Oxford cloth provides some water resistance, but prolonged exposure to heavy rain or direct sun should be avoided.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate airflow through the mesh windows, especially in warmer conditions.

### 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning assembly:

- Pet Stroller Frame with main compartment
- Front Wheels (2 units)
- Rear Wheels (2 units)
- Cup Holder (1 unit)
- Tray Holder (1 unit)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

### 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow these steps to assemble your BestPet Pet Stroller:

1. **Unfold the Frame:** Carefully remove the stroller frame from its packaging. Locate the folding mechanism (often a latch or button near the handle or side) and release it to fully extend the frame until it locks into an upright position.
2. **Attach Rear Wheels:** Insert the rear wheels into their designated slots on the back legs of the stroller. Push firmly until they click into place. Ensure the brake mechanism on each wheel is facing outwards.
3. **Attach Front Wheels:** Insert the front wheels into their designated slots on the front legs. Push firmly until they click into place. These wheels are designed to swivel 360 degrees.
4. **Install Cup and Tray Holders:** Attach the cup holder and tray holder to the handle bar or designated attachment points. These typically slide or clip into place.
5. **Final Check:** Before use, gently push and pull the stroller to ensure all wheels are securely attached and the frame is fully locked. Verify that the canopy and mesh enclosures operate smoothly.

### 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

#### 5.1 Placing Your Pet in the Stroller

- Open the main compartment zipper or latch.
- Gently place your pet inside.
- Secure your pet using the internal 5-point safety harness. Adjust straps for a snug, comfortable fit.
- Close the compartment securely, ensuring all zippers are fully fastened and mesh windows are properly aligned.

#### 5.2 Using the Brakes

- The stroller is equipped with rear wheel brakes. To engage, press down on the red lever located on each rear wheel assembly.
- To release the brakes, lift the red lever upwards.
- Always engage the brakes when the stroller is stopped or when loading/unloading your pet.

- To fold the stroller, locate the folding mechanism (often a button or lever on the handle or side frame).
- Activate the mechanism and push the handle forward or pull it up, depending on the design, to collapse the frame.
- Ensure the stroller is fully folded and latched for compact storage and transport.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

### 6.1 Cleaning

- **Fabric:** The Oxford cloth is water-resistant. Wipe down fabric surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners. Allow to air dry completely.
- **Mesh:** Gently clean mesh windows with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid excessive scrubbing to prevent damage.
- **Frame:** Wipe the metal frame with a damp cloth. Dry thoroughly to prevent rust.

### 6.2 Wheel Care

- Regularly check wheels for debris, dirt, or hair that may impede their movement. Clean as needed.
- Ensure wheels rotate freely. If they become stiff, a small amount of silicone-based lubricant can be applied to the axles.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Stroller does not fold/unfold easily:** Ensure all locking mechanisms are disengaged before attempting to fold, and fully engaged when unfolding. Check for any obstructions.
- **Wheels are stiff or squeaky:** Clean wheels thoroughly to remove debris. Apply a small amount of lubricant to the wheel axles if necessary.
- **Stroller feels unstable:** Verify that all wheels are securely attached and the frame is fully locked in the open position. Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity.
- **Pet seems uncomfortable:** Ensure the harness is not too tight or loose. Check for proper ventilation. Consider adding a soft blanket for added comfort.
