# Nikon Coolpix P100 Digital Camera Instruction Manual

## INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Nikon Coolpix P100 digital camera. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation of your camera. The Nikon Coolpix P100 is a high-performance digital camera featuring a 10.3-megapixel CMOS sensor, a powerful 26x optical Zoom-NIKKOR ED glass lens, and Full HD (1080p) video recording capabilities. Its advanced features, including 5-way VR Image Stabilization and a 3-inch vari-angle LCD, are designed to enhance your photography experience.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

To prevent damage to your Nikon Coolpix P100 and to avoid injury to yourself or others, please read the following safety precautions before using the camera:

- Do not disassemble or modify the camera.
- Keep the camera dry. Do not expose it to water or high humidity.
- Use only Nikon-approved accessories and power sources.
- Keep out of reach of children.
- Avoid pointing the lens at the sun or other strong light sources for extended periods.

## Key Components

- **Lens:** NIKKOR 26x optical zoom lens.
- **LCD Monitor:** 3.0-inch vari-angle high-resolution HVGA Clear Color Display.
- **Electronic Viewfinder (EVF):** For precise framing.
- **Mode Dial:** Select shooting modes (P, S, A, M, Scene, etc.).
- **Shutter-release Button:** To capture photos.
- **Zoom Control:** Adjust optical zoom.
- **Movie-record Button:** Start/stop video recording.
- **Flash:** Built-in pop-up flash.
- **Control Pad:** For menu navigation and setting adjustments.
- **Menu Button:** Access camera settings.
- **Playback Button:** View captured images and videos.

## SETUP

### 1. Installing the Battery and Memory Card

Open the battery/memory card cover on the bottom of the camera. Insert the EN-EL5 battery, ensuring correct orientation. Insert an SD/SDHC/SDXC memory card until it clicks into place. Close the cover securely.

### 2. Charging the Battery

Connect the camera to the EH-68P AC Adapter/Charger using the UC-E6 USB Cable. Plug the charger into a power outlet. The charging indicator will light up during charging and turn off when complete. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours and 30 minutes.

### 3. Initial Setup (Date, Time, Language)

Turn on the camera using the power button. Follow the on-screen prompts to set the date, time, and desired language. These settings are crucial for proper image management.

## OPERATING THE CAMERA

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### 1. Taking Photos

- **Power On:** Press the power button to turn on the camera.
- **Select a Mode:** Rotate the mode dial to select your desired shooting mode (e.g., Auto, Programmed Auto [P], Shutter-priority Auto [S], Aperture-priority Auto [A], Manual [M], or a Scene Mode).
- **Frame Your Shot:** Use the 3.0-inch vari-angle LCD or the electronic viewfinder to compose your image. Adjust the vari-angle LCD for comfortable shooting from various angles.
- **Zoom:** Use the zoom control to adjust the 26x optical zoom for wide-angle or telephoto shots.
- **Focus:** The camera will automatically focus on your subject. For specific focus points, use the control pad to select. The Smart Portrait System automatically detects faces and optimizes settings.
- **Image Stabilization (VR):** The 5-way VR Image Stabilization System automatically reduces blur caused by camera shake.
- **Flash:** If needed, press the flash button to pop up the built-in flash.
- **Capture:** Press the shutter-release button halfway to focus, then press fully to take the picture.

### 2. Recording Videos

- **Start Recording:** Press the dedicated Movie-record button to begin recording Full HD (1080p) video with stereo sound.
- **Zoom During Video:** The optical zoom and autofocus functions remain active during video recording.
- **HS Movie Function:** Utilize the high-speed movie function for slow-motion or fast-motion playback effects.
- **Stop Recording:** Press the Movie-record button again to stop recording.

### 3. Viewing Images and Videos

- **Playback Mode:** Press the Playback button to enter playback mode.
- **Navigate:** Use the control pad to scroll through your photos and videos.
- **Zoom In/Out:** Use the zoom control to magnify photos or view multiple images at once.
- **Play Video:** Select a video and press the OK button to play.

## ADVANCED FEATURES

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- **Smart Portrait System:** Enhances portraits with features like Face-priority AF, Smile Timer, Blink Warning, Blink Proof, In-Camera Red-Eye Fix, and Skin Softening.
- **Active D-Lighting:** Optimizes images by preserving details in both highlights and shadows, resulting in more natural-looking photos.
- **Backlit Scene HDR:** Merges multiple exposures to create a single image with a wider dynamic range, ideal for high-contrast scenes.
- **High-Speed Shooting:** Capture fast-moving action at up to 10 frames per second at full resolution.
- **17 Scene Modes:** Optimize camera settings for specific situations (e.g., Landscape, Portrait, Night Scene).
- **Subject Tracking:** Maintains focus on a moving subject.
- **Distortion Control:** Corrects barrel or pincushion distortion in images.
- **Quick Retouch:** Enhance photos directly in the camera after shooting.

## CONNECTIVITY

- **USB Connection:** Connect the camera to a computer using the UC-E6 USB cable for image transfer or battery charging.
- **HDMI Output:** Connect the camera to an HDTV using an HDMI cable (not included) to view your photos and videos on a larger screen.

## MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Camera:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the camera body. For the lens, use a lens brush or blower to remove dust, then gently wipe with a lens cleaning cloth.
- **Battery Care:** Store the battery in a cool, dry place when not in use. Avoid fully discharging the battery for extended periods.
- **Storage:** When storing the camera for long periods, remove the battery and memory card. Store in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Nikon Coolpix P100, try the following basic troubleshooting steps:

- **Camera does not turn on:** Ensure the battery is fully charged and correctly inserted.
- **Images are blurry:** Check that the lens is clean. Ensure the camera is stable and the 5-way VR is active. Adjust lighting conditions if necessary.
- **Memory card error:** Reinsert the memory card. If the error persists, try a different, compatible memory card.
- **Flash does not fire:** Ensure the flash is popped up and the shooting mode allows flash use.
