LG BD570 Network Blu-ray Disc Player User Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your LG BD570 Network Blu-ray Disc Player. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference. The LG BD570 offers high-definition Blu-ray playback, DVD up-scaling, and network connectivity for streaming various online content.

SETUP

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure all items listed in the 'What's in the Box' section are present.

2. Physical Connections

Connect the player to your television and home network using the appropriate cables.

- **HDMI Connection:** For optimal high-definition video and audio, connect an HDMI cable from the 'HDMI OUT'

port on the player to an HDMI input on your TV.

- **LAN Connection:** For a wired network connection, connect an Ethernet cable from the 'LAN (100)' port on the player to your router or modem.
- **USB Connection:** The 'USB (BD STORAGE)' port can be used for external storage devices to expand BD-Live memory or play media files.
- **Power Connection:** Connect the power cord to the player and then to a wall outlet.

The rear panel of the LG BD570 includes various ports for connectivity. These typically include an HDMI output for high-definition audio and video, a LAN (Ethernet) port for wired internet access, and a USB port for external storage or media playback. Some models may also feature an RS-232C port for control systems and composite video output.

3. Network Setup

The LG BD570 supports both wired and wireless network connections (802.11n). Upon first power-on or when accessing network features, the player will guide you through the network setup process. Select your preferred connection type and follow the on-screen instructions to connect to your home network.

4. Initial Power On

After all connections are made, power on the player. The unit features a quick boot function and instant tray opening for convenience. Follow any on-screen prompts for initial setup, such as language selection and display settings.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Disc Playback

Insert a Blu-ray Disc or DVD into the disc tray. The player will automatically detect the disc and begin playback or display a menu. The BD570 supports Full HD 1080p output for Blu-ray discs and 1080p up-scaling for standard DVDs, enhancing picture quality.

2. Streaming Services (NetCast)

The LG BD570 features NetCast, providing access to various online content services. Navigate to the NetCast menu on your TV screen using the remote control. Available services include Netflix, YouTube, and CinemaNow. An active internet connection is required to access these services.

3. USB Media Host

Connect a USB storage device to the USB port on the player. You can then access and play various media files (photos, music, videos) stored on the device through the player's interface.

4. DLNA (Digital Living Network Alliance)

The BD570 supports DLNA, allowing you to stream media content from compatible devices on your home network, such as computers or network-attached storage (NAS) drives, directly to your TV via the Blu-ray player.

MAINTENANCE

1. Software Updates

Periodically check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features and security enhancements. Updates can typically be performed directly through the player's network connection or via USB.

2. Cleaning

To clean the exterior of the player, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid or aerosol cleaners. For the disc tray, ensure no dust or debris accumulates, which could affect disc playback.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely connected to both the player and a working electrical outlet.
- **No Picture:** Verify that the HDMI cable is correctly connected to both the player and the TV, and that the TV input is set to the correct HDMI source.
- **No Sound:** Check audio connections and TV/receiver volume settings. Ensure the player's audio output settings are configured correctly.
- **Network Connection Issues:** Confirm your router is working and the player is correctly connected (wired or wireless). Restarting your router and the player may resolve temporary issues.
- **Disc Playback Errors:** Ensure the disc is clean and free of scratches. Try another disc to determine if the issue is with the player or the disc.
