3. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Positioning:** Place the Tube Talon around the 1-inch PEX tubing at the desired fastening point on a wood surface.

- Alternating Direction:** For secure installation, it is recommended to install fasteners in alternating directions. This means the integrated nail should be on alternating sides of the tubing being fastened along its run.
- Fastening Intervals:** Install fasteners at intervals that comply with local plumbing codes for the specific type of pipe or tube being fastened. Consult your local codes for precise requirements.
- IPS Tube Sizing:** When fastening IPS (Iron Pipe Size) tube, use the next larger size fastener. For example, if you are fastening 1/2-inch IPS tube, use a 3/4-inch fastener. This 1-inch Tube Talon is designed for 1-inch PEX tubing.
- Secure Attachment:** Drive the integrated nail into the wood surface until the Tube Talon is firmly secured and the tubing is held in place without excessive movement.
