INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the assembly, care, and maintenance of your Sajan Iconic Monk Pathfinder Miniature (Model RPR60016/REM60016) by Reaper Miniatures. These miniatures are designed for tabletop gaming and display. Key features of this product include:

- Miniatures are supplied unpainted, allowing for custom artistic expression.
- Assembly may be required for certain components.
- Reaper miniatures are designed to a 28mm scale, compatible with many popular tabletop gaming systems.
- Miniatures vary in size, typically ranging from 0.25 inches to 3 inches depending on the specific item.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Your Sajan Iconic Monk miniature is supplied unpainted and may require assembly of certain parts. Follow these general guidelines for preparation and assembly:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect for any visible damage.
2. **Cleaning:** It is recommended to gently wash the miniature parts with mild soap and water to remove any mold release agents. Allow parts to dry completely.
3. **Assembly:** Use a hobby-grade super glue or epoxy adhesive suitable for miniatures. Apply a small amount of adhesive to the joining surfaces and hold the parts firmly together until the bond sets. Refer to the product image for correct positioning of parts.

4. **Preparation for Painting:** Once assembled and fully cured, you may prime the miniature with a suitable primer designed for miniatures to ensure paint adhesion.

Recommended Tools: Hobby knife or clippers for sprue removal (if applicable), fine-grit sandpaper or file for smoothing, and appropriate adhesive.

OPERATING AND DISPLAY

While miniatures do not 'operate' in the traditional sense, proper handling and display are crucial for their longevity and enjoyment.

- **Handling:** Always handle the miniature by its base to avoid damaging painted surfaces or delicate parts. Avoid dropping or applying excessive force.
- **Display:** Display your miniature in a stable, secure location away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or high humidity, which can cause paint to fade or materials to degrade.
- **Gaming Use:** When using the miniature in tabletop games, ensure it is placed on a flat, stable surface. Be mindful of other game components and player interactions to prevent accidental damage.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance helps preserve the condition of your miniature.

- **Cleaning:** Dust can accumulate on miniatures. Use a soft, dry brush (like a makeup brush or soft paintbrush) to gently remove dust. For more stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, but avoid excessive moisture, especially on unsealed paint.
- **Storage:** If storing the miniature, use a padded case or container to prevent chipping or breakage. Ensure it is stored in a cool, dry place.
- **Repair:** In case of accidental breakage, use a strong hobby adhesive to reattach parts. For very small or delicate breaks, consider using a small pin (pinning) for added strength before gluing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues that may arise with miniatures.

- **Broken or Bent Parts Upon Arrival:** Due to the delicate nature of miniatures, small parts like weapons or limbs may occasionally arrive bent or detached. Gently attempt to bend bent parts back into shape if they are flexible. For detached parts, use a strong hobby adhesive to reattach them. If the damage is significant and cannot be repaired, contact the retailer or manufacturer for assistance.
- **Material Discrepancy:** If the miniature's material (e.g., plastic vs. metal) does not match your expectation, verify the product description from your purchase source. Reaper Miniatures produces figures in various materials, including pewter and Bones (plastic).
- **Paint Not Adhering:** If paint does not adhere well, ensure the miniature was properly cleaned and primed before painting. Mold release agents can prevent paint adhesion.
