INTRODUCTION

Key Features

- Mobile case with extendable telescopic handle for easy transport.
- Constructed from highly impact-resistant ABS material for durability.
- Robust aluminum frame with edge protection for enhanced safety.
- Features removable tool boards with various compartments on both front and back sides.
- Bottom section offers freely divisible compartments with dimensionally stable partitions for systematic storage.

SETUP

Unpacking

Carefully remove the tool case from its packaging. Inspect the case for any signs of damage that may have occurred during transit. Retain packaging materials for future storage or transport if needed.

Initial Configuration

The tool case comes with removable tool panels and adjustable dividers for the bottom compartment. To configure:

1. Open the case by releasing the latches.
2. The top section contains removable tool panels. These panels can be detached by releasing their fastening mechanisms (e.g., hook-and-loop fasteners or clips) to access the main compartment or to organize tools more conveniently.
3. The bottom compartment features slots for inserting the provided dimensionally stable dividers. Arrange these dividers to create custom-sized sections suitable for your tools and equipment.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Organizing Tools

Utilize the various compartments and features to organize your tools efficiently:

- **Removable Tool Panels:** Use the elastic loops and pockets on the removable panels to secure screwdrivers, pliers, wrenches, and other hand tools. These panels can be easily removed for access or reconfigured.
- **Bottom Compartment:** The adjustable dividers in the bottom shell are ideal for larger tools, power tools, or spare parts. Arrange them to prevent items from shifting during transport.
- **Lid Compartments:** Some models may feature additional pockets or straps in the lid for documents or smaller items.

Transporting the Case

The TOOLCRAFT Run 821400 is designed for mobile use:

- **Telescopic Handle:** Extend the telescopic handle by pressing the release button and pulling it upwards. Ensure it is fully extended and locked in place before pulling the case.
- **Wheels:** The integrated wheels allow for smooth rolling transport over various surfaces.
- **Carrying Handle:** For short distances or lifting, use the robust top carrying handle.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your tool case:

- Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these can damage the ABS material and aluminum frame.
- Ensure the case is dry before closing and storing.

Storage

Store the tool case in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to prolong its lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues

- **Case not closing properly:** Ensure no tools are obstructing the closing mechanism or the edges of the case. Check that the removable panels are correctly seated.
- **Telescopic handle stuck:** Ensure the release button is fully depressed. Check for any debris or obstructions in the handle mechanism. Do not force the handle.
- **Dividers not fitting securely:** Ensure the dividers are inserted correctly into the designated slots in the bottom compartment. They should fit snugly to provide stable partitioning.


