## INTRODUCTION

The BRIO World 33280 Freight Goods Station is a versatile toy train set designed to provide interactive play and learning opportunities. This set encourages creative thinking, spatial awareness, and fine motor skill development. It is fully compatible with all other BRIO World railway toys, allowing for extensive expansion and diverse play scenarios. Constructed from high-quality, durable wood sourced from well-managed forests and certified by The Forest Stewardship Council, this toy prioritizes both safety and sustainability.

## WHAT'S IN THE BOX

The BRIO World 33280 Freight Goods Station includes the following components:

- 1x Freight Station with magnetic crane and cargo chute
- 1x Tipper Truck
- 1x Cargo Wagon
- 2x Cargo Loads (magnetic)
- 1x Off-track Slope

## SETUP

To set up your Brio World 33280 Freight Goods Station:

- 1. Assemble Track Layout:** Connect the Freight Station to your existing Brio World railway tracks using the provided off-track slope and any other compatible track pieces. Ensure all connections are secure.
- 2. Position Components:** Place the tipper truck and cargo wagon on the tracks near the station. The cargo wagon should be positioned to receive cargo from the chute.
- 3. Prepare Cargo:** Place the magnetic cargo loads into the tipper truck or near the magnetic crane for loading.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Freight Goods Station offers several interactive features:

### Magnetic Crane Operation

- Position the magnetic crane arm over a cargo load. The magnet will automatically attach to the cargo.
- Use the red knob on the crane to raise or lower the magnetic arm, lifting the cargo.
- Swing the crane arm to move the cargo from one location to another, such as from the truck to the cargo chute.

### Cargo Chute Function

- Once the magnetic crane has placed a cargo load onto the cargo chute, ensure a cargo wagon is positioned directly below the chute's exit.
- Press the red button on the side of the chute to activate the sliding mechanism. The cargo will slide down and land in the waiting cargo wagon.

### Tipper Truck and Cargo Wagon

- The tipper truck can transport cargo loads. Its bed can be tilted to unload cargo.
- The cargo wagon features special dowels to securely hold cargo loads during transport on the railway.
- Connect the tipper truck and cargo wagon to other BRIO trains using their magnetic couplings.

### MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and safe play of your BRIO World 33280 Freight Goods Station:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe all wooden and plastic components with a slightly damp cloth. Avoid using harsh cleaning agents or abrasive materials.
- **Drying:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before storing to prevent warping or mold growth.
- **Storage:** Store the toy in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight or extreme temperatures.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect all components for any signs of wear, damage, or loose parts. Discontinue use if any damage is found and contact customer support.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Freight Goods Station, consider the following:

- Track Connection Issues:** Ensure all track pieces are firmly connected. BRIO tracks are designed for a snug fit.
- Cargo Not Loading/Unloading:** Check that the magnetic crane is properly aligned with the cargo and that the cargo wagon is correctly positioned under the chute. Ensure the chute button is fully pressed.
- Magnetic Couplings:** If magnetic couplings are not holding, ensure they are clean and free from debris.
- General Malfunction:** If a component is not functioning as expected, re-read the operating instructions and ensure all parts are correctly assembled.


