1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not attempt to open or repair the device yourself. Refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the device during operation.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

- Remote Control (with batteries)
- Power Adapter
- HDMI Cable

3. SETUP

3.1 Connecting Your Player

- 1. Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI OUT port on your Players Media Player.
- 2. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to an available HDMI IN port on your TV or display. Note the HDMI input number (e.g., HDMI 1, HDMI 2).
- 3. Connect the power adapter to the DC IN port on the Players Media Player.

4. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet.

3.2 Initial Power On and Network Setup

- 1. Turn on your TV and select the correct HDMI input source (e.g., HDMI 1).
- 2. The Players Media Player will automatically power on and display the setup wizard.
- 3. Follow the on-screen instructions to select your language, time zone, and connect to your Wi-Fi network. You will need your Wi-Fi network name (SSID) and password.
- 4. If prompted, update the device firmware to the latest version for optimal performance.

4. OPERATING YOUR PLAYER

4.1 Remote Control Overview

Familiarize yourself with the remote control buttons:

- Power Button: Turns the device on/off or puts it into standby.
- Navigation Pad (Up/Down/Left/Right/OK): Used to navigate menus and select items.
- Home Button: Returns to the main home screen.
- Back Button: Goes back to the previous screen or menu.
- Volume +/-: Adjusts the volume.
- Play/Pause, Fast Forward, Rewind: Media playback controls.

4.2 Basic Navigation and Media Playback

From the home screen, use the navigation pad to browse available apps and content. Select an app (e.g., a streaming service) by pressing the OK button. Within an app, navigate to your desired content and press OK to start playback.

4.3 Advanced Features (Example: Screen Mirroring)

Your Players Media Player may support screen mirroring from compatible devices. To enable this feature, navigate to *Settings > Display > Screen Mirroring* and follow the on-screen instructions to connect your smartphone or tablet.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning Your Device

To clean the Players Media Player, unplug it from the power outlet. Use a soft, dry, lint-free cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces. Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or abrasive solvents.

5.2 Firmware Updates

Periodically check for firmware updates to ensure your device has the latest features and security enhancements.

Navigate to *Settings > System > Software Update* and select 'Check for Updates'. Follow any on-screen prompts to install available updates.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Players Media Player, refer to the table below for common problems and solutions.

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-------------------------------|--|--|
| No power | Power adapter not connected; outlet not working | Ensure power adapter is securely connected to device and a working outlet. Try a different outlet. |
| No picture on | Incorrect HDMI input selected; loose HDMI cable | Verify TV is on correct HDMI input. Check HDMI cable connections at both ends. Try a different HDMI port or cable. |
| No sound | TV volume muted; audio settings incorrect | Unmute TV volume. Check audio settings on the Players Media Player (Settings > Audio). |
| Wi-Fi connection issues | Incorrect password; router issues; signal interference | Re-enter Wi-Fi password. Restart your Wi-Fi router. Move device closer to router or reduce interference. |
| Remote control not working | Dead batteries; obstructed sensor | Replace batteries. Ensure no obstructions between remote and device. |
