Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer. This mechanical timer is designed for precise timekeeping up to 60 minutes, featuring an audible alarm. Its compact design allows for versatile placement, either wall-mounted or freestanding on a table.

2. SETUP

The Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer is ready for use out of the box as it is a mechanical device and does not require batteries. It offers two primary placement options:

- **Tabletop Placement:** Simply place the timer on any flat, stable surface.
- **Wall Mounting:** The timer features a keyhole slot on its back for wall installation. Secure a screw (not included) into your desired wall location, ensuring it is strong enough to hold the timer. Hang the timer onto the screw using the keyhole slot.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To set and use your Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer, follow these steps:

1. **Wind the Timer:** Rotate the red arrow (timer knob) clockwise a full 360 degrees until it reaches the 60-minute mark. This action winds the internal mechanism, ensuring the alarm will sound.
2. **Set the Desired Time:** After winding, rotate the red arrow counter-clockwise to your desired time setting (e.g., 10 minutes, 30 minutes).
3. **Start Timing:** The timer will begin counting down immediately after setting.
4. **Alarm Notification:** Once the set time has elapsed, an audible alarm will sound to notify you.

4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and proper functioning of your Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer, follow these simple maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the timer with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn marks, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** Store the timer in a dry environment, away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- **Handling:** Handle the timer with care. Avoid dropping it or subjecting it to strong impacts, as this can damage the internal mechanical components.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Technoline KZW Analog Short-Term Timer, consider the following:

- **Timer Not Counting Down:** Ensure you have fully wound the timer by rotating the knob clockwise to the 60-minute mark before setting your desired time. The winding action is crucial for the mechanism to

engage.

- **Alarm Not Sounding:** If the alarm does not sound, verify that the timer was fully wound as described above. A partial wind may not provide enough tension for the alarm mechanism to trigger.
- **Inaccurate Timing:** Mechanical timers can have slight variations. For best accuracy, ensure the timer is placed on a stable, level surface. If significant inaccuracy persists, the internal mechanism may be faulty.
