

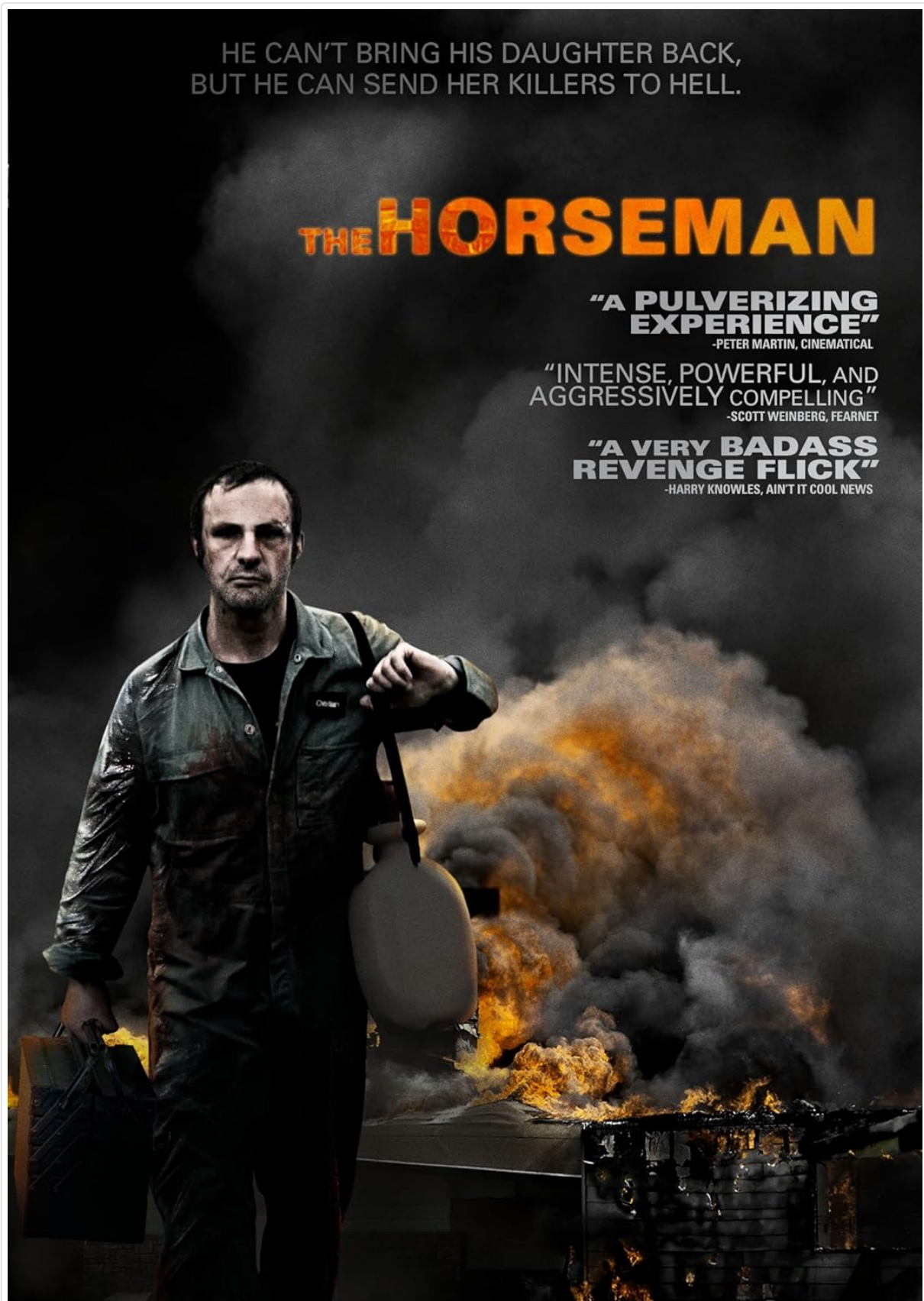

INTRODUCTION

1. SETUP

1. **Unpack the DVD:** Carefully remove the DVD disc from its packaging. Handle the disc by its edges to avoid fingerprints on the playing surface.

3. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Handling:** Always hold the DVD disc by its outer edges or by placing a finger through the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.
- **Cleaning:** If the disc becomes dirty or smudged, gently wipe it with a soft, lint-free cloth (such as a microfiber cloth) from the center outwards. Do not use abrasive materials or harsh cleaning solvents. For

stubborn marks, a specialized DVD cleaning solution can be used sparingly.

- **Storage:** Store the DVD disc in its original case when not in use. Keep it away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, high humidity, and dust. Proper storage prevents scratches and prolongs disc life.
- **Avoid Bending:** Do not bend or flex the disc, as this can cause irreparable damage.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|------------------------------------|--|---|
| Disc does not play or load. | Disc inserted incorrectly, dirty disc, incompatible player, or player malfunction. | Ensure disc is inserted label-side up. Clean the disc. Verify your player supports DVD format. Try another DVD to check player functionality. |
| Movie skips or freezes. | Scratched or dirty disc, or player lens issue. | Clean the disc thoroughly. Inspect for deep scratches. If the problem persists with other discs, the player's lens may need cleaning or servicing. |
| No audio or video during playback. | Incorrect TV input, loose cables, or player settings. | Check that your TV is on the correct input source. Ensure all audio/video cables between the DVD player and TV are securely connected. Verify player's audio/video output settings. |
| Cannot access special features. | Incorrect menu selection. | From the main menu, navigate specifically to the 'Special Features' section and select the desired option. |





