### **Product Overview**

### **Safety Information**

Before each use, ensure all components are securely fastened and in good working order. Always adhere to the maximum load capacity of 50 kg for the bike rack and your vehicle's tow bar. Ensure bicycles are properly secured to prevent movement during transit. Verify that vehicle lights and license plate are clearly visible and unobstructed. Drive cautiously, especially when cornering or braking, as the vehicle's center of gravity will be altered.


# **Setup and Installation**

The EUFAB Raven bike rack is designed for quick and straightforward installation on a standard tow bar. Follow these steps for proper setup:

- 1. **Unfold the Rack:** Remove the rack from its storage bag. Carefully unfold the main frame and light bar assembly until it locks into place.
- 2. Mount on Tow Bar: Place the rack onto the tow bar. Engage the clamping mechanism by pressing down the lever

firmly until it clicks, indicating a secure connection.

- 3. **Secure the Clamp:** Use the integrated locking mechanism to secure the rack to the tow bar. Insert the key and turn to the locked position to prevent unauthorized removal.
- 4. **Connect Electrics:** Plug the rack's electrical connector into your vehicle's tow bar socket. Verify that all lights (tail lights, brake lights, turn signals) are functioning correctly.
- 5. Adjust Bike Holders: Adjust the bike frame holders and wheel trays to accommodate your bicycles.

## **Operating Instructions**

Once installed, the EUFAB Raven bike rack offers convenient features for transporting and accessing your vehicle's trunk.

### **Loading Bicycles**

- Place the first bicycle into the wheel trays, ensuring the wheels are properly seated.
- Secure the bicycle frame to the main support arm using the provided frame clamps. Ensure the clamps are tightened firmly but without overtightening to avoid damage to the bike frame.
- Use the wheel straps to secure the bicycle wheels to the wheel trays.
- Repeat the process for the second bicycle, ensuring proper spacing and stability.

### **Tilting Function for Trunk Access**

The rack features a convenient tilting mechanism, allowing access to your vehicle's trunk even with bicycles loaded.

- To tilt the rack, locate the tilt release lever (usually near the base of the main support).
- Engage the lever and carefully tilt the rack downwards, away from the vehicle.
- Once tilted, you can open your vehicle's trunk.
- After accessing the trunk, push the rack back upwards until it locks securely into its upright position.

### Maintenance

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your EUFAB Raven bike rack.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the rack with mild soap and water after each use, especially if exposed to dirt, salt, or harsh weather conditions. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely to prevent corrosion.
- **Lubrication:** Periodically lubricate moving parts, such as the tilting mechanism and clamping lever, with a suitable lubricant to ensure smooth operation.
- Fastener Check: Regularly inspect all bolts, screws, and straps for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners to ensure the rack remains secure.
- **Storage:** When not in use, fold the rack and store it in its accompanying bag in a dry, protected area to prevent damage and prolong its lifespan.

# **Troubleshooting**

If you encounter issues with your EUFAB Raven bike rack, consider the following common solutions:

- Rack Feels Loose: Ensure the clamping mechanism is fully engaged and locked onto the tow bar. Check that the tow bar ball is clean and free of grease.
- **Lights Not Working:** Verify that the electrical connector is fully inserted into the vehicle's socket. Check the vehicle's fuses and the rack's wiring for any visible damage.
- Difficulty Tilting: Ensure the tilt release lever is fully actuated. Lubricate the pivot points if movement is stiff.
- **Bicycles Not Secure:** Re-check all frame clamps and wheel straps. Ensure they are tightened appropriately and that the bikes are balanced on the rack.


