#### **INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for purchasing the GPX DH300B 1080p Upconversion DVD Player with HDMI. This device is designed to enhance your viewing experience by upconverting standard definition DVDs to near high-definition resolutions (720p, 1080i, or 1080p) for compatible HDTVs. It supports a variety of disc formats, including DVD, DVD+/-R/RW, CD, CD-R/RW, and JPEG CDs, and features multiple audio and video output options for versatile connectivity.

#### PRODUCT OVERVIEW

#### **Front Panel Controls**

The front panel of your GPX DH300B DVD Player provides essential controls for basic operation:

- Disc Tray: Insert DVDs or CDs here.
- Open/Close Button: Opens and closes the disc tray.
- Play/Pause Button: Starts or pauses disc playback.
- Stop Button: Stops disc playback.
- Power Button: Turns the unit on or off.
- USB Port: For playing media from a USB flash drive.

#### **Rear Panel Connections**

The rear panel offers various ports for connecting the DVD player to your television or audio system:

- **HDMI Output:** For digital audio and video connection to an HDTV. Supports 720p, 1080i, 1080p upconversion.
- S-Video Output: For video connection to a TV.
- Composite Video Output (Yellow RCA): For standard definition video connection.
- Coaxial Digital Audio Output: For digital audio connection to a compatible audio receiver.
- RCA Stereo Audio Output (Red/White): For analog stereo audio connection.

## 1. Connecting to a Television

Choose the appropriate connection method based on your television's available inputs:

#### **HDMI Connection (Recommended for HDTVs)**

- 1. Ensure both the DVD player and your TV are powered off.
- 2. Connect one end of an HDMI cable (not included) to the **HDMI OUT** port on the back of the DVD player.
- 3. Connect the other end of the HDMI cable to an HDMI IN port on your television.
- 4. Power on your TV and select the corresponding HDMI input using your TV's remote control.

## **RCA Composite Video Connection**

- 1. Ensure both the DVD player and your TV are powered off.
- 2. Connect the yellow plug of the RCA audio/video cable to the VIDEO OUT (yellow) port on the DVD player.
- 3. Connect the red and white plugs of the RCA audio/video cable to the AUDIO OUT R (red) and AUDIO

OUT L (white) ports on the DVD player.

- 4. Connect the other ends of the RCA cables to the corresponding VIDEO IN and AUDIO IN (R/L) ports on your television.
- 5. Power on your TV and select the corresponding AV input.

#### 2. Power Connection

The DVD player has a built-in AC power cable. Plug this cable into a standard 120V AC wall outlet.

#### 3. Remote Control Battery Installation

The remote control requires two AAA batteries (not included). Open the battery compartment on the back of the remote and insert the batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-).

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

### 1. Powering On/Off

Press the Power button on the front panel of the DVD player or on the remote control to turn the unit on or off.

#### 2. Disc Playback

- 1. Power on the DVD player and your television.
- 2. Press the Open/Close button on the front panel or remote control to open the disc tray.
- 3. Place a DVD or CD onto the disc tray with the label side facing up.
- 4. Press the Open/Close button again to close the disc tray. The player will begin loading the disc.
- 5. Playback should start automatically. If a menu appears, use the arrow buttons on the remote to navigate and the **OK** button to select.
- 6. Use the Play/Pause and Stop buttons for playback control.

# 3. USB Playback

The GPX DH300B supports media playback from a USB flash drive. Insert your USB drive into the USB port on the front panel. Use the remote control to navigate the on-screen menu and select your desired media files (e.g., JPEG images).

# 4. On-Screen Display (OSD) and Settings

The multi-language on-screen display allows you to adjust various video and audio settings. Press the **SETUP** button on the remote control to access the setup menu. Use the arrow buttons to navigate and **OK** to confirm selections.

#### 5. Remote Control Functions

The included full-function remote control provides comprehensive control over the DVD player. Key functions include:

- Power On/Off
- Open/Close Disc Tray
- Play, Pause, Stop, Fast Forward, Rewind
- Chapter Skip (Next/Previous)
- Volume Control
- Setup Menu Access
- Navigation (Arrow buttons, OK)
- Subtitle, Audio, Angle selection

# MAINTENANCE

# **Cleaning the Unit**

Wipe the exterior of the DVD player with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as they may damage the finish.

## **Cleaning Discs**

Wipe discs from the center outwards with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid touching the playback surface of the disc. Do not use solvents such as benzene, thinners, or commercially available cleaners, as they may damage the disc.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; outlet not active.	Ensure power cable is securely plugged into a working outlet.
No picture	Video cable not connected; incorrect TV input selected.	Check video cable connections (HDMI or RCA). Select the correct input source on your TV.
No sound	Audio cable not connected; TV/receiver volume too low or muted.	Check audio cable connections (HDMI or RCA).  Adjust volume on TV/receiver. Ensure not muted.
Disc not playing	Disc is dirty, scratched, or incompatible format.	Clean the disc. Try a different disc. Ensure the disc format is supported (DVD, CD, JPEG CD).
Remote control not working	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted; obstruction between remote and player.	Replace batteries, ensuring correct polarity. Remove any obstructions. Ensure remote is pointed at the player.
