## 1. INTRODUCTION

The Kampa Utility Privacy Tent, model CT9001, is a versatile and quick-pitch shelter designed for various outdoor privacy needs. It is ideal for use as a changing room, shower enclosure, or portable toilet tent during camping, picnics, or other outdoor activities. This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your privacy tent.

Key features include a unique hybrid frame for easy setup, a stable ground frame, a removable Velcro ground sheet suitable for a shower tray, and an integrated toilet roll holder. The tent is constructed from durable, waterproof polyester material.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Fire Safety:** Keep all flame and heat sources away from the tent fabric. The tent is made of flammable material and will burn if exposed to a flame source.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation when using the tent, especially if using any heating or cooking appliances nearby. Never use fuel-burning devices inside the tent.
- **Secure Pitching:** Always secure the tent firmly to the ground using all provided pegs and guy lines. Failure to do so may result in the tent being blown away or damaged in windy conditions.
- **Weather Conditions:** Avoid pitching the tent under trees where falling branches could cause injury. Do not use the tent in extreme weather conditions such as heavy storms, strong winds, or lightning.
- **Children:** Keep children away from the tent during setup and takedown to prevent injury from poles or other components.

## 3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to set up your Kampa Utility Privacy Tent:

1. **Unpack:** Remove the tent and all components from the carry bag. Lay the tent fabric flat on a clear, level surface.

2. **Assemble Frame:** The top section of the hybrid frame is designed to pop into shape. Extend the legs and connect them to the top frame. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Position Tent:** Stand the tent upright in your desired location.
4. **Install Ground Frame:** Insert the ground frame poles into the designated sleeves at the base of the tent. This frame enhances stability.
5. **Secure Tent:** Use the provided pegs to anchor the tent's base to the ground. Attach and tension all guy lines, securing them with pegs at an appropriate angle to maximize stability. Ensure the tent fabric is taut to prevent water pooling.
6. **Ground Sheet (Optional):** If using for showering, attach the removable Velcro ground sheet to the tent floor.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The Kampa Utility Privacy Tent is designed for simple and effective use:

- **Entry/Exit:** Use the zippered door for easy access. Ensure the zipper is fully closed for maximum privacy.
- **Privacy:** The tent provides a private enclosure for changing clothes, using a portable toilet, or taking an outdoor shower.
- **Shower Use:** If using as a shower tent, ensure the removable Velcro ground sheet is securely attached to contain water. Place your shower tray on this sheet.
- **Toilet Roll Holder:** Utilize the integrated holder for convenience when using a portable toilet.
- **Ventilation:** The tent may include ventilation points (e.g., mesh windows or roof vents). Open these

as needed to improve airflow and reduce condensation.

## 5. MAINTENANCE

---

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your privacy tent:

- **Cleaning:** Clean the tent fabric with a soft brush or sponge, using mild soap and lukewarm water. Do not use harsh detergents, bleach, or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the waterproof coating. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Drying:** Always ensure the tent is completely dry before packing it away. Packing a damp tent can lead to mildew, odors, and fabric degradation. Air dry in a shaded area if possible.
- **Storage:** Store the clean, dry tent in its original carry bag in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Zippers:** Keep zippers clean and lubricated with a silicone-based spray to ensure smooth operation.
- **Repairs:** Inspect the tent regularly for any damage to the fabric, poles, or seams. Repair small tears with a tent repair kit.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tent instability in wind	Insufficiently secured pegs or guy lines; weak pegs.	Ensure all guy lines are taut and pegs are driven firmly into the ground. Consider using heavier-duty pegs or additional anchoring in very windy conditions.
Water pooling on roof	Tent not pitched tautly enough; sagging fabric.	Re-tension guy lines and adjust poles to ensure the roof fabric is stretched tightly, allowing water to run off.
Difficulty assembling poles	Poles not aligned correctly; plastic ends detached.	Ensure all pole sections are fully inserted and aligned. If plastic ends detach, reattach them securely before assembly.
Lack of privacy (silhouettes visible)	Strong sunlight shining directly on the tent.	Reposition the tent to a shaded area or orient it so that direct sunlight does not illuminate the interior.
