1. INTRODUCTION

The Iomega ScreenPlay Director HD Media Player is designed to provide a comprehensive media experience, allowing users to store, access, and enjoy their digital content on a home theater system. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

This device connects to your home network, enabling access to videos, music, and photo collections. It supports a wide range of media formats and offers online content access.

4. SETUP

4.1 System Requirements

- **PC:** Microsoft® Windows® 2000 Professional, XP Home/XP Professional/XP Professional x64, Windows Vista™, Windows 7
- **Mac:** Mac® OS X 10.4 – 10.6
- Network router or hub recommended (sold separately)

4.2 Connecting the Device

Follow these steps to connect your ScreenPlay Director to your home entertainment system and network:

1. **Power Connection:** Connect the power supply to the ScreenPlay Director and then to a power outlet.
2. **Video Connection:**
 - For High-Definition (HD) output, use the provided HDMI cable to connect the ScreenPlay Director's HDMI port to an HDMI input on your HDTV.
 - Alternatively, for standard definition, use the composite video cable (yellow, red, white) to connect to your TV's corresponding inputs. Component video (Y, Pb, Pr) is also supported for higher quality analog connections.
3. **Audio Connection:**
 - If using HDMI, audio will be transmitted through the HDMI cable.
 - For separate audio, connect the audio R/L (red/white) cables to your TV or audio receiver. An optical audio output is also available for digital audio connections.
4. **Network Connection:**
 - **Wired:** Connect an Ethernet cable from your network router to the Ethernet port on the ScreenPlay Director.
 - **Wireless (Optional):** If you have an Iomega USB Wi-Fi adapter (sold separately), connect it to one of the USB ports on the ScreenPlay Director for wireless network access (supports 802.11b/g/n).
5. **USB Devices:** Use the additional USB ports to connect external storage devices, cameras, or flash drives.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Basic Navigation

Use the provided remote control to navigate the ScreenPlay Director's interface. The directional pad and 'OK' button are central for menu selection and content playback.

5.2 Accessing Stored Media

To play media stored on the device or connected USB drives:

1. Turn on the ScreenPlay Director and your television.
2. Select the correct input source on your television.
3. Navigate to the 'My Files' section using the remote.
4. Browse through folders (Videos, Music, Photos) to locate your desired content.
5. Select a file to begin playback.

5.3 Network Media Access

The ScreenPlay Director can access media files shared on your home network:

1. Ensure the device is connected to your network (wired or wireless).
2. Navigate to the 'Network' section from the main menu.
3. Browse available network shares and select the media you wish to play.

5.4 Online Content

Access pre-installed online content sites and RSS feeds:

1. From the main menu, select the 'Internet' or 'Online Content' option.
2. Choose from pre-configured sites like Flickr or YouTube.
3. You can also add your favorite RSS media feeds.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Cleaning

To clean the device, use a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosol sprays, as they may damage the unit.

6.2 Firmware Updates

Periodically check the Iomega support website for firmware updates. Updating the firmware can improve performance, add new features, or resolve issues.

6.3 Data Management

Regularly back up important data stored on the ScreenPlay Director to another storage device to prevent data loss. The included Iomega Protection Suite software can assist with backup solutions.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **No Power:**

Ensure the power adapter is securely connected to the device and a working power outlet. Check the power indicator light on the unit.

- **No Video Output:**

Verify that the HDMI or composite video cable is correctly connected to both the ScreenPlay Director and your television. Ensure your television is set to the correct input source (e.g., HDMI 1, AV).

- **No Audio Output:**

Check audio cable connections (if not using HDMI). Ensure your TV or audio receiver volume is not muted or too low. Confirm audio settings on the ScreenPlay Director.

- **Cannot Connect to Network:**

For wired connections, ensure the Ethernet cable is properly connected and your router is functioning. For wireless, verify the Iomega USB Wi-Fi adapter is connected and configured correctly. Check network settings on the device.

- **Slow Performance/Freezing:**

If the device is slow or freezes, try restarting it by disconnecting and reconnecting the power. Ensure the device is not overheating. Large media libraries or network traffic can sometimes affect performance.

- **Cannot Play Certain Files:**

Refer to the Specifications section for supported CODECs and file types. Ensure your media files are compatible. Some files may require specific codecs not supported by the device.


