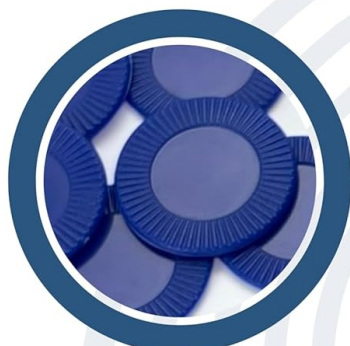
INTRODUCTION

The LCR® Left Center Right™ Dice Game is an upscale version of the popular LCR game, designed for fast-paced and engaging play. It's a simple yet exciting dice game that can be enjoyed by 3 to 100 players, making it ideal for various social settings from family game nights to large gatherings. SETUP

To begin the game, each player starts with three playing chips. Any remaining chips should be set aside as they are not used in the current game. Players should sit in a circle or around a table to facilitate easy passing of chips.

While the game comes with blue playing chips, players may opt to use their own currency, such as dollar bills or coins, to increase the stakes and excitement. Ensure all players agree on the chosen currency before starting.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS: HOW TO PLAY

LCR® is played in rounds. The objective is to be the last player with chips remaining. The game is fast-paced and relies on the roll of three specialty dice.

Gameplay Mechanics

- The first player rolls all three dice.
- For each 'L', 'C', or 'R' rolled, the player must pass one chip according to the die's instruction.
- For each 'Dot' (•) rolled, the player keeps their chip.
- If a player has fewer than three chips, they only roll a number of dice equal to their remaining chips. For example, if a player has two chips, they roll two dice. If they have one chip, they roll one die.
- If a player has no chips, they do not roll the dice but remain in the game. They can re-enter if another player passes them a chip.
- Play continues clockwise to the next player.

Dice Meanings

- **L (Left):** Pass one chip to the player on your left.
- **C (Center):** Place one chip in the center pot.
- **R (Right):** Pass one chip to the player on your right.
- **Dot (•):** Keep your chip. No action required.

Winning the Game

The game ends when only one player has chips remaining. That player wins all the chips in the center pot.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE



The compact tin case keeps all game pieces secure and makes it easy to store and travel.

To ensure the longevity of your LCR® Left Center Right™ Dice Game, follow these simple care instructions:

- Store all dice and chips in the provided blue tin case when not in use to prevent loss and damage.
- Keep the game components away from excessive moisture and direct sunlight.
- Clean the dice and chips with a soft, dry cloth if they become dirty. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
