INTRODUCTION

The Bose Lifestyle V35 home entertainment system is designed to deliver vivid surround sound for movies and music. This system incorporates Bose Unify technology for simplified setup and operation, guiding users through connections and verifying them. It supports up to 6 HD video and audio sources, including Blu-ray Disc players, cable boxes, and gaming systems. The system also features an iPod/iPhone-compatible dock and a built-in AM/FM tuner.

- **5-speaker surround sound system:** Designed for integration with your home entertainment components, including four Jewel Cube speakers.
- **Unify Intelligent Integration System:** Uses on-screen navigation to simplify system setup and daily use, guiding you through connections and verifying them.
- **ADAPTiQ Audio Calibration System:** Analyzes your room's acoustics and adjusts the system's sound for consistent, high-quality performance.
- **Multiple HD Inputs:** Supports up to 6 HD sources, including 4 HDMI and 2 audio HD connections.
- **Bose® link Whole-Home Audio Technology:** Allows connection of compatible Bose products for audio distribution to up to 4 additional rooms.
- **3D Compatibility:** Ensures content is displayed as intended with 3D TVs, Blu-ray Disc players, and other 3D sources.
- **Bose® Remote:** Features fewer buttons and an LED screen for simplified management of entertainment sources, operating via radio frequency.
- **iPod/iPhone-compatible Dock:** Expands music listening, charges your device, and allows control of content via the Bose remote.
- **Acoustimass® Module:** Works with small speakers to deliver a fuller range of theater sound and effects, producing low frequencies without audible distortion.
- **Direct/Reflecting® Speaker Technology:** Delivers lifelike spaciousness from a natural balance of reflected and direct sound.
- **Automatic Video Upscaling:** Ensures movies and sports utilize the highest resolution capabilities of your display,

up to 1080p over HDMI.

- **Proprietary Videostage® 5 Decoding:** Combines with digital 5.1 decoding and DTS® for high-quality, multichannel surround sound from various sources.

SETUP

Unpacking and Component Identification

Carefully unpack all components from the box. Verify that all items listed in the "What's in the Box" section are present and undamaged. Keep packaging materials for future transport or storage.

Connecting Your System with Unify Technology

The Unify Intelligent Integration System simplifies the setup process by providing on-screen guidance. Follow the prompts on your TV screen as you connect each component.

1. **Connect the Control Console to your TV:** Use the provided HDMI cable to connect the HDMI OUT port on the control console to an HDMI IN port on your television.
2. **Power On:** Connect the power supply to the control console and plug it into a power outlet. Turn on your TV and select the correct HDMI input.
3. **Follow On-Screen Instructions:** The Unify system will automatically detect connected devices and guide you through connecting speakers, the Acoustimass module, and other entertainment sources. It will recommend the best connectors and verify proper connections.
4. **Connect Entertainment Sources:** Connect your Blu-ray player, cable box, gaming console, etc., to the appropriate

HDMI, optical, coaxial, or analog audio inputs on the control console. The Unify system will help identify and label these sources on your TV screen.

ADAPTiQ Audio Calibration

After connecting all components, the ADAPTiQ system will guide you through calibrating the sound to your specific room. This process uses a special headset to measure the room's acoustics and optimize the system's performance for your listening area.

1. Plug the ADAPTiQ headset into the designated port on the control console.
2. Wear the headset and follow the on-screen instructions, moving to different listening positions as prompted.
3. The system will play a series of tones to analyze the room and adjust the sound settings automatically.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Remote Control

The Bose remote control is designed to manage your Lifestyle V35 system and most connected entertainment sources. It uses radio frequency, allowing operation without direct line-of-sight.

- **Source Selection:** Use the source buttons on the remote or the on-screen menu to switch between connected devices (e.g., Blu-ray, Cable/Sat, Game).
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the master volume using the dedicated volume buttons.
- **System Information:** The remote's LED screen displays system information, including iPod and FM/AM status.
- **Programming:** The Unify system automatically programs the remote during setup to control connected components.

iPod/iPhone Dock Usage

The included dock allows you to play audio and video content from your compatible iPod or iPhone through the Lifestyle V35 system.

- Connect your iPod or iPhone to the dock.
- Select the iPod/iPhone source on your system.
- Use the Bose remote to navigate and control your device's content. The device will charge while docked.

AM/FM Tuner

The system includes a built-in AM/FM tuner for radio listening.

- Connect the provided AM and FM antennas to the control console.
- Select the AM or FM source on your remote.
- Tune to your desired stations using the remote control.

Bose® link Whole-Home Audio

Bose link technology allows you to expand your audio experience to other rooms or even outdoors by connecting compatible Bose products. Refer to the documentation of your Bose link compatible products for specific connection and operation instructions.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning Your System

- Always disconnect the system from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the surfaces of the control console, speakers, and Acoustimass module.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, sprays, or solvents, as they may damage the finish or internal components.
- Keep ventilation openings clear of dust and debris to ensure proper airflow.

Software Updates

The system may receive software updates via the USB flash drive provided. Refer to the Bose support website for instructions on how to check for and apply updates to ensure optimal performance and compatibility.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Bose Lifestyle V35 system, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps. For more detailed assistance, consult the full operating guide or the Bose support website.

No Power

- Ensure all power cords are securely connected to the control console, power supply, and a working electrical outlet.
- Check if the power outlet is functional by plugging in another device.

No Sound

- Verify that the correct input source is selected on the control console and your TV.
- Check all speaker connections to the Acoustimass module and the module's connection to the control console.
- Ensure the system volume is not muted or set too low.
- Confirm that the audio output settings on your connected source devices (e.g., Blu-ray player, cable box) are correctly configured for digital audio output.

No Picture

- Ensure the HDMI cable from the control console to the TV is securely connected.
- Verify that your TV is set to the correct HDMI input.
- Check the video connections from your source devices to the control console.

Remote Control Not Working

- Replace the batteries in the remote control.
- Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the control console, although the remote uses RF, extreme interference can affect it.
- If the remote was recently programmed, try re-running the Unify setup process for remote programming.
