Nanoblock NBH-012 Mont-Saint-Michel Micro-Sized Building Block Kit Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides guidance for assembling and maintaining your Nanoblock NBH-012 Mont-Saint-Michel micro-sized building block kit. This kit allows you to construct a detailed 3D model of Mont-Saint-Michel using miniature building blocks. It contains approximately 390 pieces and is rated with a difficulty level of 3, indicating a challenging yet rewarding building experience.

2. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

2.1 Before You Begin

- Unpack all contents carefully. Ensure all block bags and the instruction booklet are present.
- Prepare a clean, well-lit, and stable workspace. Due to the small size of the blocks, a clear surface is essential to prevent loss of pieces.
- Review the included pictorial instruction booklet thoroughly before starting assembly. Familiarize yourself with the symbols and step-by-step diagrams.

2.2 Sorting Blocks

It is highly recommended to sort the micro-sized blocks by color and shape before beginning assembly. This will significantly aid in locating the correct pieces during construction and improve the overall building experience. Small containers or a sorting tray can be very useful for this step.

2.3 Assembly Steps

Follow the detailed pictorial instructions provided in the kit. Each step illustrates the placement of specific blocks. Pay close attention to the orientation and connection points of each piece. Due to the miniature size of the blocks, precision is key. Using tweezers (not included) may assist in handling and placing very small pieces.

3. OPERATING (DISPLAY AND HANDLING)

Once assembled, your Nanoblock Mont-Saint-Michel model is intended for display. Place it on a stable, flat surface where it can be admired without risk of being knocked over. Handle the model gently, as the micro-sized connections can be delicate. Avoid dropping or applying excessive force, which could cause pieces to detach.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To clean your assembled model, gently dust it with a soft brush or a can of compressed air. Avoid using water or chemical cleaners, as these may damage the plastic blocks or affect their color.

4.2 Storage

If disassembling for storage, keep all blocks in a secure container to prevent loss. Store the blocks away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures to maintain their integrity and color.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

5.1 Missing Pieces

In the rare event of missing pieces, first double-check your workspace and packaging. If pieces are still missing, please contact Nanoblock customer support with details of your kit and the specific missing parts.

5.2 Difficulty Assembling

If you encounter difficulty during assembly, review the instruction booklet carefully. Ensure you are using the correct blocks and placing them in the correct orientation. Take breaks if needed, and consider using fine-tipped tweezers for better grip and precision with the small blocks.

5.3 Disassembly

To disassemble the model, gently separate the blocks. Avoid pulling forcefully, which could damage the connection points. A block separator tool (if available) can be helpful.
