Note: Avoid excessive force when using the stylus, as this is unnecessary and could potentially damage the stylus tip or your device's screen.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning the Tip:** Periodically wipe the soft touch tip with a clean, dry, lint-free cloth to remove any dust or oils that may accumulate. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.
- **Cleaning the Body:** The brass body can be wiped clean with a soft, damp cloth. Ensure the stylus is completely dry before storage.
- **Storage:** Store the stylus in a clean, dry place when not in use. The integrated clip allows for secure storage in a pocket or pen loop. Avoid exposing the stylus to extreme temperatures or direct sunlight for extended periods.
- **Tip Inspection:** Regularly inspect the soft tip for any signs of wear or damage. A worn tip may reduce responsiveness or scratch the screen.

| Stylus scratches the screen. | Damaged or hardened stylus tip; debris on tip. | Immediately stop using the stylus. Inspect the tip for any damage or embedded particles. Clean the tip thoroughly. If the tip is damaged, discontinue use. |
| Stylus feels sticky or drags on screen. | Oils or residue on the screen or tip. | Clean both the stylus tip and the device screen thoroughly with appropriate cleaning solutions for electronics. |
