INTRODUCTION

SETUP

- 4. **Network Configuration:** Once the card is recognized and drivers are installed, access your operating system's network settings. Scan for available wireless networks. Select your desired network and enter the security key or passphrase if required.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

After successful installation, operating the Compaq WL100 PC Card involves managing your wireless connection:

- Connecting to a Network: Use your operating system's wireless utility to view available networks. Select the network you wish to join and click "Connect." If the network is secured, you will be prompted to enter the network key.
- Checking Connection Status: The wireless utility or network icon in your system tray will indicate the
 connection status. A strong signal strength usually means a stable connection.
- **Disconnecting:** To disconnect from a network, right-click the network icon and select "Disconnect" or use the wireless utility.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure optimal performance and longevity of your Compaq WL100 Wireless LAN PC Card:

- **Keep Drivers Updated:** Periodically check the Compaq support website for updated drivers. Newer drivers can improve performance, stability, and compatibility.
- **Physical Care:** Keep the PC Card clean and free from dust. Avoid exposing it to extreme temperatures or moisture. When not in use, store it in a protective case.
- **Proper Removal:** Always use the operating system's "Safely Remove Hardware" function before physically removing the PC Card to prevent data corruption or system issues.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Compaq WL100 PC Card, consider the following:

• Card Not Detected:

- o Ensure the card is fully seated in the PC Card slot.
- Restart your computer.
- Check Device Manager (Windows) to see if the card is listed, even with an error. Reinstall drivers if necessary.

• Cannot Connect to Network:

- Verify that the wireless network (router/access point) is powered on and functioning.
- Confirm you are entering the correct network security key (WPA/WEP).
- Check if the wireless function on your device is enabled (e.g., a physical switch or software setting).
- Move closer to the wireless access point to improve signal strength.

• Slow Connection Speed:

- Ensure there are no obstructions between your device and the wireless access point.
- Check for interference from other electronic devices.
- Update the card's drivers to the latest version.
