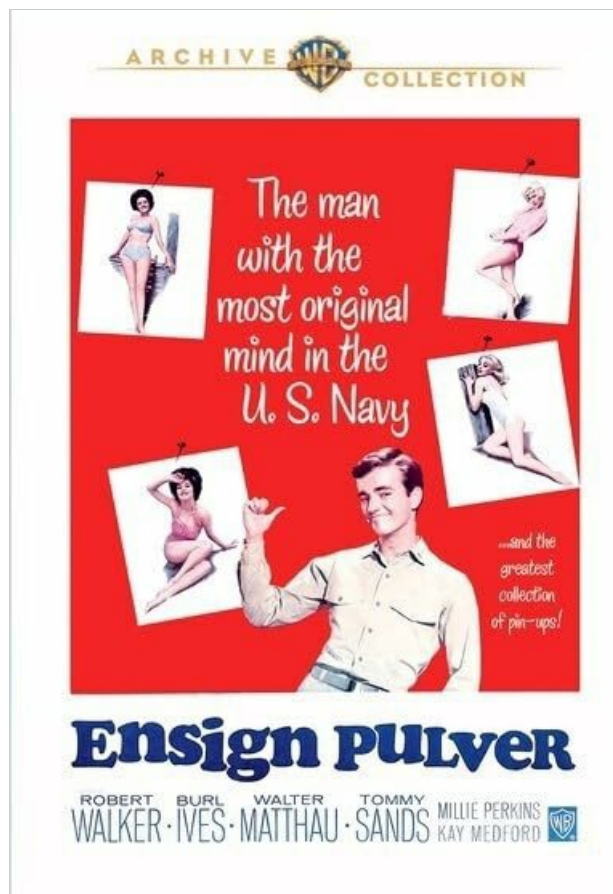


Image 1.1: Front cover of the Ensign Pulver DVD, showcasing the film's comedic and naval theme.

## 2. SETUP AND PLAYBACK

---

### 2.1 Connecting Your DVD Player

- **Handling:** Always handle the disc by its edges or the center hole. Avoid touching the shiny playback surface.

If you encounter issues during playback, try the following solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Disc not playing or loading.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure the disc is inserted correctly (label side up).</li> <li>• Clean the disc surface as described in Section 3.</li> <li>• Try playing another DVD to confirm the player is functioning correctly.</li> <li>• Restart your DVD player.</li> </ul>
Skipping, freezing, or pixelation during playback.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Clean the disc surface thoroughly.</li> <li>• Check the disc for deep scratches or damage. A severely damaged disc may not play correctly.</li> <li>• Ensure your DVD player's lens is clean (refer to your player's manual for cleaning instructions).</li> </ul>
No audio or video.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Check all cable connections between your DVD player and TV/audio system.</li> <li>• Ensure your TV input is set to the correct source for the DVD player.</li> <li>• Verify that the TV or audio system volume is not muted or set too low.</li> </ul>
