INSTRUCTION MANUAL - MODEL 16540820

Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Hansgrohe Axor Montreux Two-Handle Wall-Mounted Bathtub Faucet, Model 16540820. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning installation or use to ensure proper function and longevity of the product.

Setup and Installation

Professional installation is recommended for this wall-mounted bathtub faucet. Ensure all local plumbing codes are followed during installation.

- Preparation:** Turn off the main water supply before starting any installation work. Clear the installation area and ensure you have all necessary tools.
- Mounting:** Securely mount the faucet body to the wall according to the provided dimensions. Ensure the mounting surface is flat and stable.
- Water Connections:** Connect the hot and cold water lines to the corresponding inlets on the faucet body. Use appropriate sealants and tighten all connections securely to prevent leaks.
- Spout and Handles:** Attach the spout and the two control handles. Ensure handles operate smoothly and are correctly oriented for hot and cold water.
- Testing:** Once all connections are made, slowly turn on the main water supply and check for any leaks. Operate both handles to ensure proper water flow and temperature control.

Operating Instructions

The Hansgrohe Axor Montreux bathtub faucet features two cross-style handles for precise control of water flow and temperature.

- **Cold Water:** Turn the right handle counter-clockwise to open the cold water supply.
- **Hot Water:** Turn the left handle counter-clockwise to open the hot water supply.
- **Temperature Control:** Adjust the desired water temperature by mixing hot and cold water using both handles.
- **Flow Control:** The further you turn the handles, the greater the water flow.
- **Shut-off:** Turn both handles clockwise until they stop to completely shut off the water flow.

Maintenance and Care

Proper care will help maintain the brushed nickel finish and ensure the long-term performance of your faucet.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the faucet regularly with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner. Avoid using harsh chemicals, abrasive sponges, or cleaners containing alcohol, ammonia, or bleach, as these can damage the finish.
- **Drying:** After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry the faucet with a soft cloth to prevent water spots and mineral buildup.
- **Aerator Maintenance:** Periodically unscrew and clean the aerator (if applicable) to remove any sediment or mineral deposits that may affect water flow.
- **Leak Checks:** Regularly inspect connections for any signs of leaks. Tighten connections as needed, but do not overtighten.

Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your faucet, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Low Water Flow:**
 - Check if the main water supply is fully open.
 - Clean the aerator for any blockages.
 - Inspect water supply lines for kinks or obstructions.
- **Leaking from Spout:**
 - Ensure handles are fully closed.
 - If persistent, internal components may require inspection by a qualified plumber.
- **Leaking from Base/Connections:**
 - Check and tighten all water supply connections. Do not overtighten.
 - Ensure proper sealing washers are in place.
- **Difficulty Turning Handles:**
 - Mineral buildup may be affecting the cartridge. Cleaning or replacement of the cartridge may be necessary.
