SETUP

- Adjust the earcup positions along the frame to achieve a comfortable and secure fit.




Image: A user wearing the Logitech H555 headset, demonstrating the behind-the-head fit and microphone positioning.

Once connected and adjusted, the Logitech H555 headset is ready for use with various audio applications.

Volume Control and Mute Function

- The headset cable includes an inline control pod.
- Volume Dial: Rotate the dial to increase or decrease the listening volume.

• **Mute Button:** Press the button to mute or unmute the microphone. An indicator light (if present) may show the mute status.




Image: A user wearing the Logitech H555 headset, with a clear view of the inline control pod on the cable for volume and mute functions.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the earcups and headset frame. Avoid liquid cleaners directly on the components.
- **Storage:** The H555 headset is designed to fold flat for portability. Fold the earcups inward and the microphone boom alongside the frame before storing it in its protective pouch or a safe place.




Image: The Logitech H555 headset in its folded configuration, demonstrating its compact design for travel and storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Logitech H555 headset, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Solution
No sound from headset	 Ensure the USB connector is fully inserted into the port. Check the volume dial on the inline control and your computer's system volume. Verify that the Logitech H555 is selected as the default playback device in your operating system's sound settings. Try a different USB port.
Microphone not working	 Ensure the microphone mute button on the inline control is not activated. Verify that the Logitech H555 is selected as the default recording device in your operating system's sound settings and in your communication software. Check microphone privacy settings in your operating system.
Poor audio quality	 Ensure the USB connection is stable. Adjust the microphone position to optimize voice input. Close other applications that might be consuming system resources.
